



A brachypterous bush-cricket occurring mainly in the south-eastern Europe. The natural range reaches its northern boarder in Eastern Slovakia and the centre of the distribution lies in the Romanian Carpathians and Transylvania. It is a species of mesophile grasslands, dry shrubs and forest fringes. It occurs on stands with dense and tall vegetation.

The conservation status in both the Alpine and the Pannonian biogeographical regions is 'unfavourable inadequate'. The species occurs in several fragmented populations, the habitat of the species is negatively affected by biocenotic evolution.
