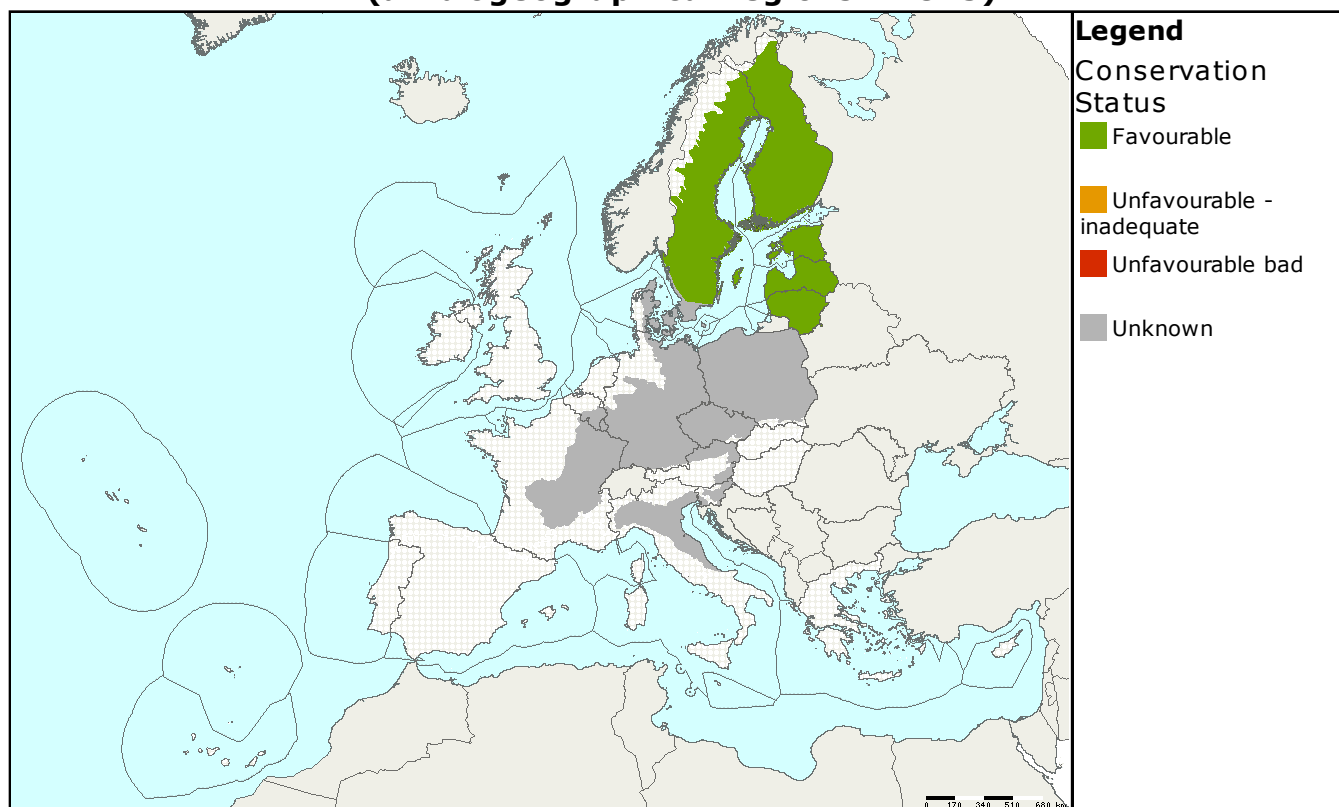

A Euro-Siberian moth species known only from the north-eastern Europe. Apart from the countries where it was reported it is occasionally recorded in Finland. The habitat of the species is unknown.

Although this species is in general very poorly known, it is possible to conclude that the conservations status in the Boreal biogeographical region is 'favourable'. In the Continental biogeographical region it is 'unknown'. The species is known here only from one locality, but possibly it occurs also elsewhere.
