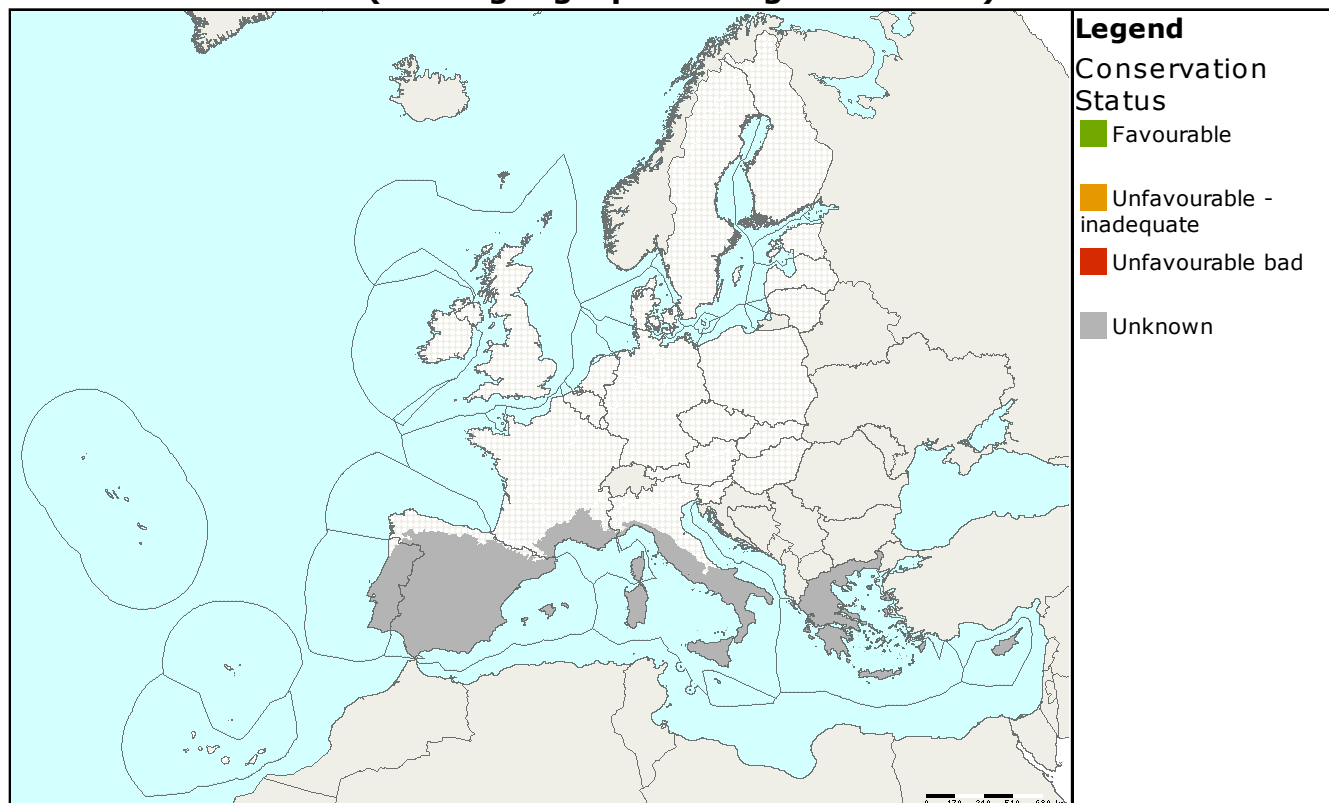

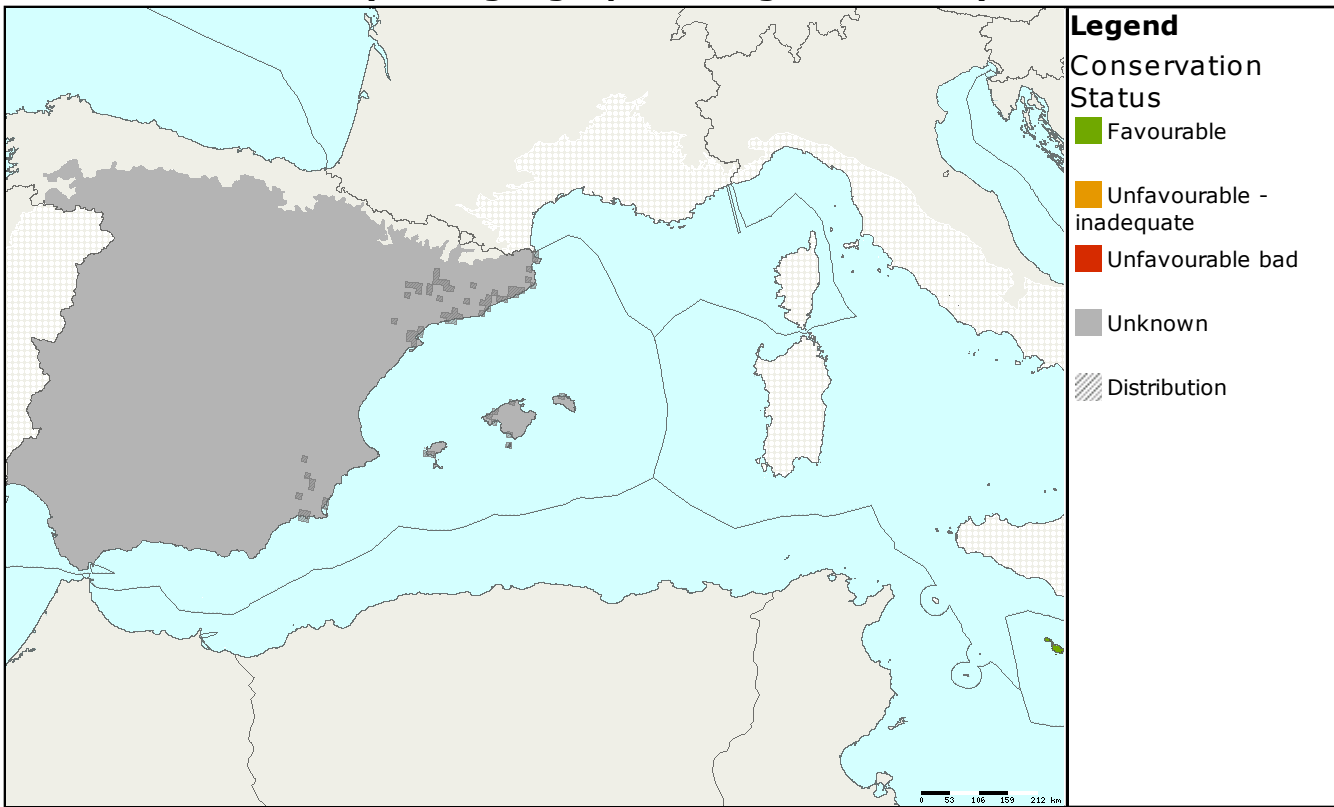

The Algerian hedgehog occurs in Mediterranean including North Africa. It is reported by Malta and Spain. It is assessed as 'favourable' in Malta, but lack of information in Spain leads to a regional assessment as 'unknown'. Spain should provide more complete information.
