

The grey long-eared bat is restricted to Europe, excluding northern countries. It hunts in lowland valleys and open agricultural landscapes in central Europe, and in a great variety of open and semi-open habitats in southern Europe. Major threats are use of pesticides and intensification of agriculture.

Looking at the overall assessments there is a major lack of data for this species in all regions and for various parameters. Among reported data there is significant difference among various countries. Overall assessments are 'unknown' for Alpine, Continental, Mediterranean and Atlantic regions. In the Mediterranean region species is very poorly known. For Pannonian region assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate' and for Macaronesian it is 'unfavourable-bad'. The only country that has reported it as 'favourable' is Belgium.


According to IUCN it is considered as 'least concern'.
