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

The Atlantic spotted dolphin inhabits continental and deep oceanic waters of the mid-tropical Atlantic. Its range and abundance are however still very unknown. The overall marine Macaronesian region assessment is 'unknown' even though some sighting frequency data for the island of Madeira indicates the presence of numerous individuals from Spring-Autumn. The species' knowledge gap on its conservation status reflects its global listing as 'data deficient' in the IUCN Red List of threatened species.
