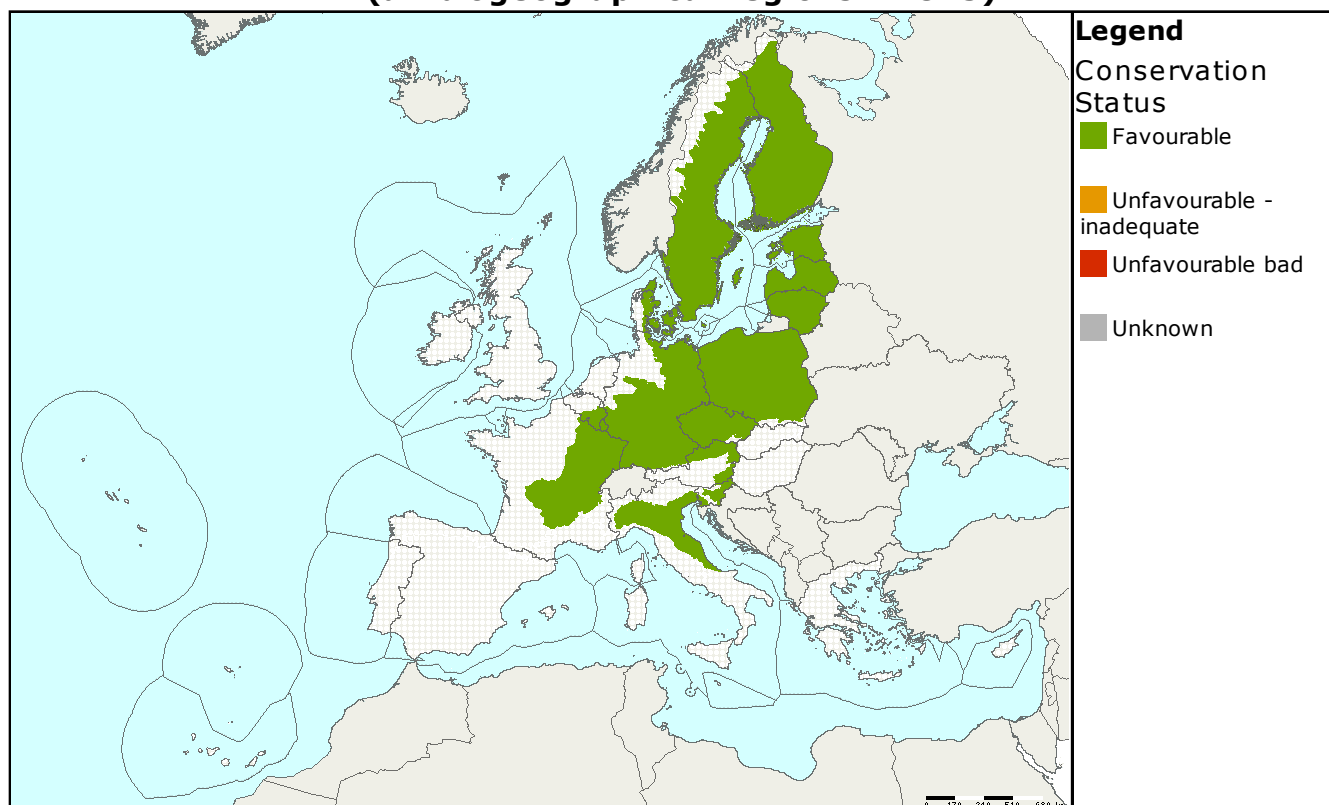

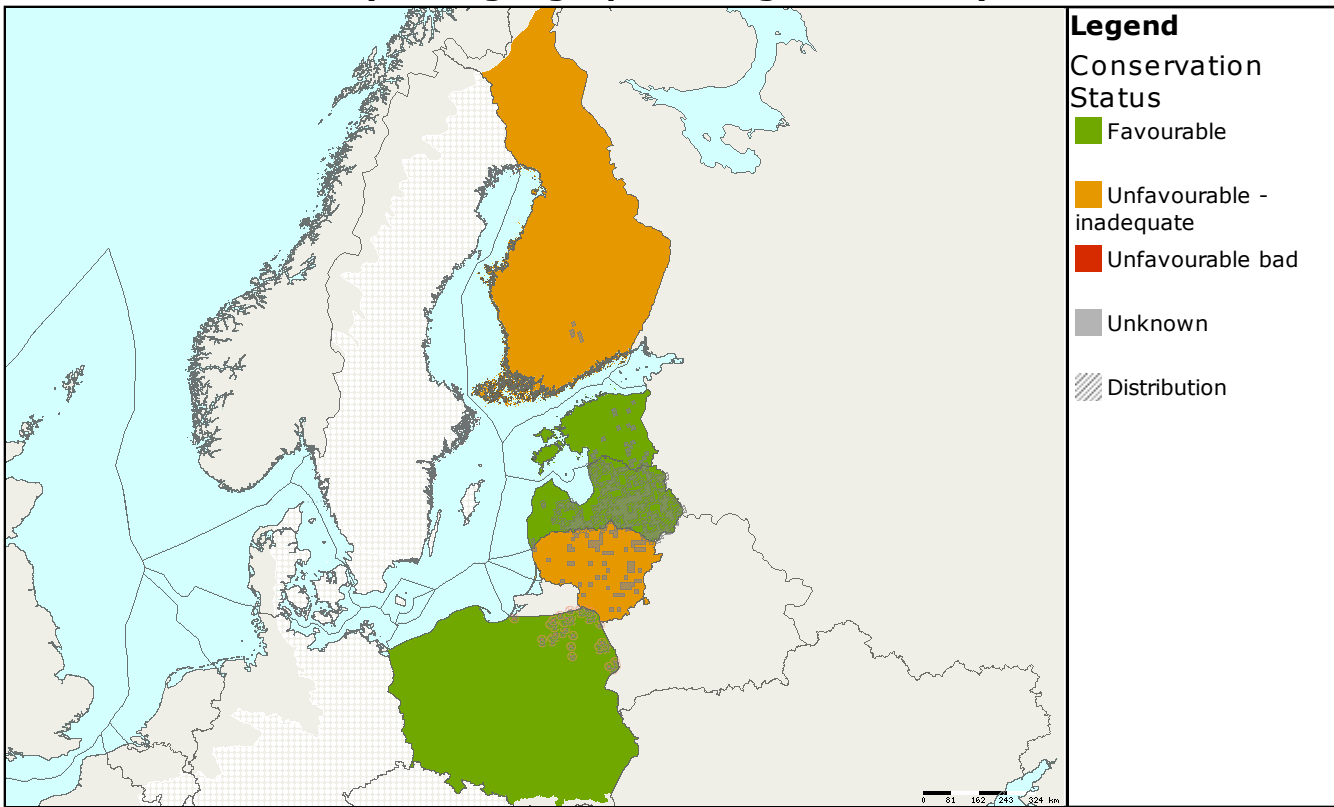

A plant species occurring in the continental part of Eurasia. The localities in the Central and Eastern Europe represent the western margin of its natural range. Within EU apart from the countries where it was reported it occurs as well in Romania. It is mainly a species of forests and forests margins and in various positions within its natural range it occurs in deciduous, mixed and as well coniferous forests.

The conservation status in both the Boreal and the Continental biogeographical regions is 'favourable'. The range, the population size and the habitat area are stable. No major threats to the species and its habitat were recorded.
