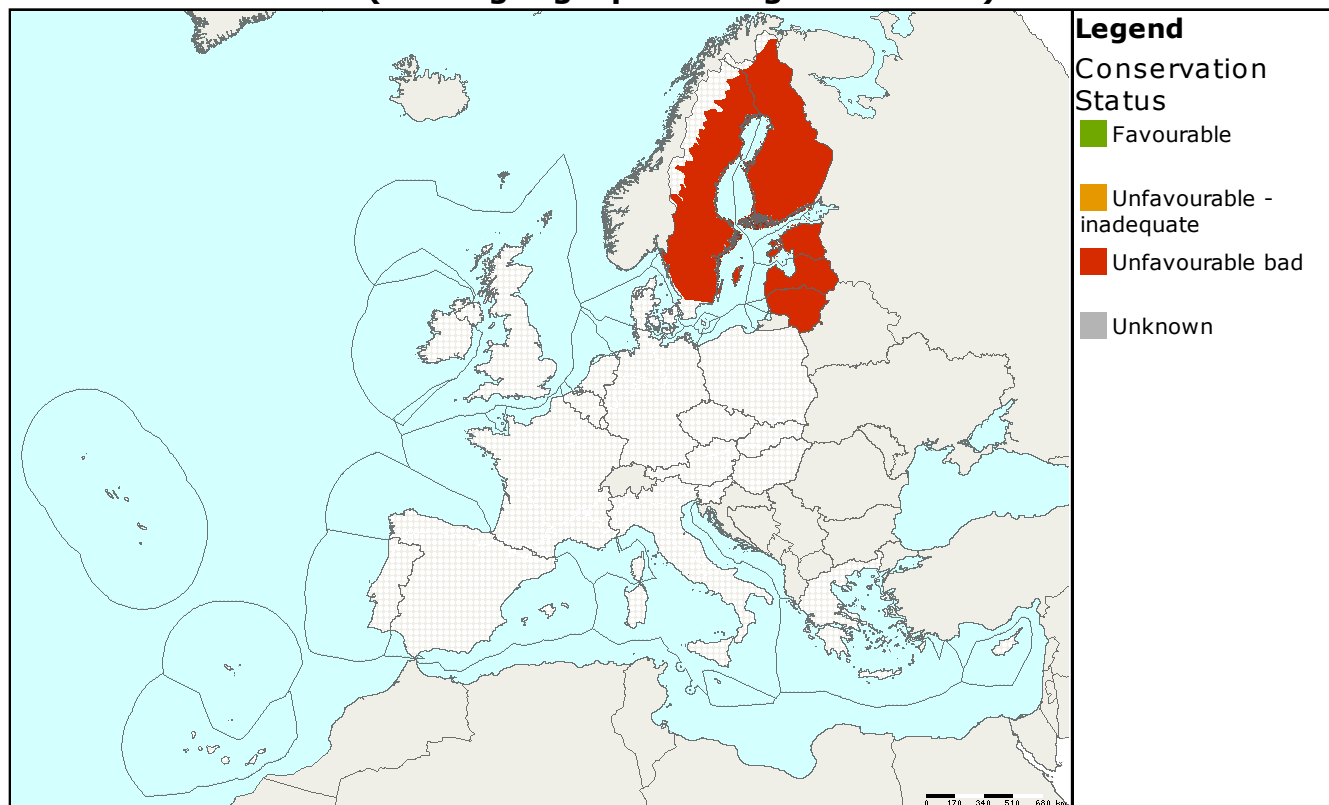

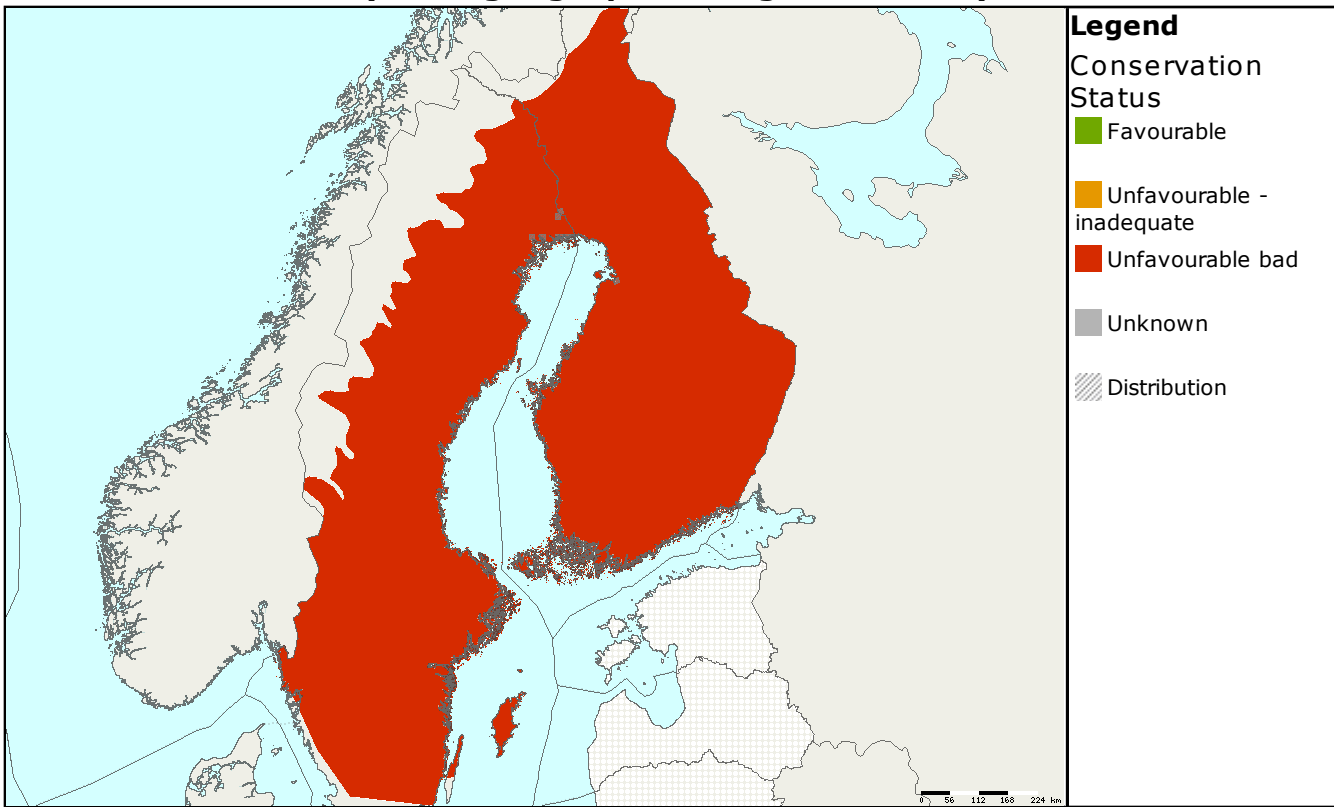

Arctophila fulva is a plant from grasses family. It occurs in northern parts of Europe, Asia and North America. It is reported from the northern coast of the Gulf of Bothnia (Baltic Sea) between Sweden and Finland (Boreal region). 80% of population reported from Finland. Overall conclusion is 'unfavourable-bad', the same as reported by both Finland and Sweden. No favourable parameter and no knowledge about the area of suitable habitat are reported.
