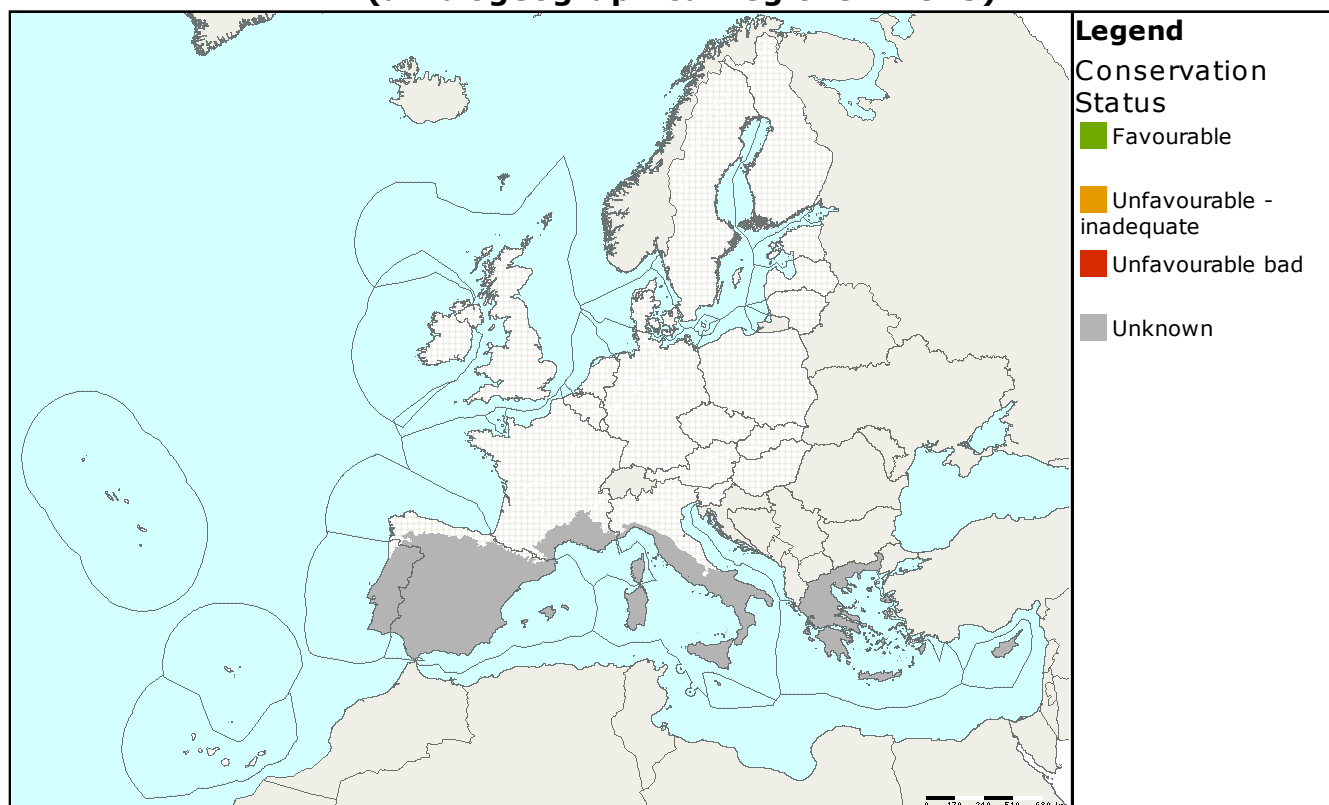

MED: Reported only from Greece mostly as unknown, but with good future prospects. This species occurs in inaccessible places - only in crevices, ledges and almost vertical cliffs of hard limestone, therefore it is not subjected to human interventions and activities, which could pose a threat to its survival. Although no actual data exist to prove it in the MS factsheet, according to Greece it is relatively safe to predict that this species' conservation status should be estimated as 'favourable'. Nevertheless, the final conclusion is "unknown".
