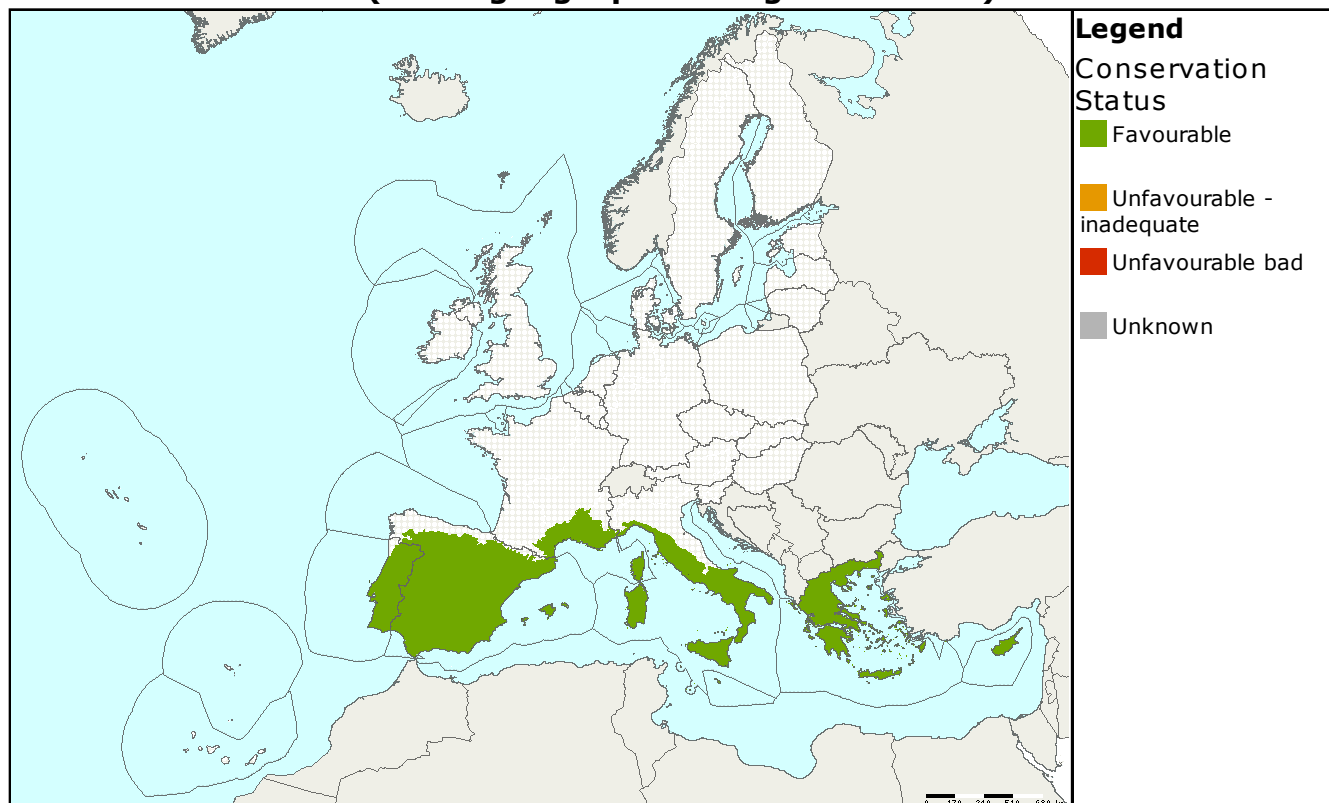

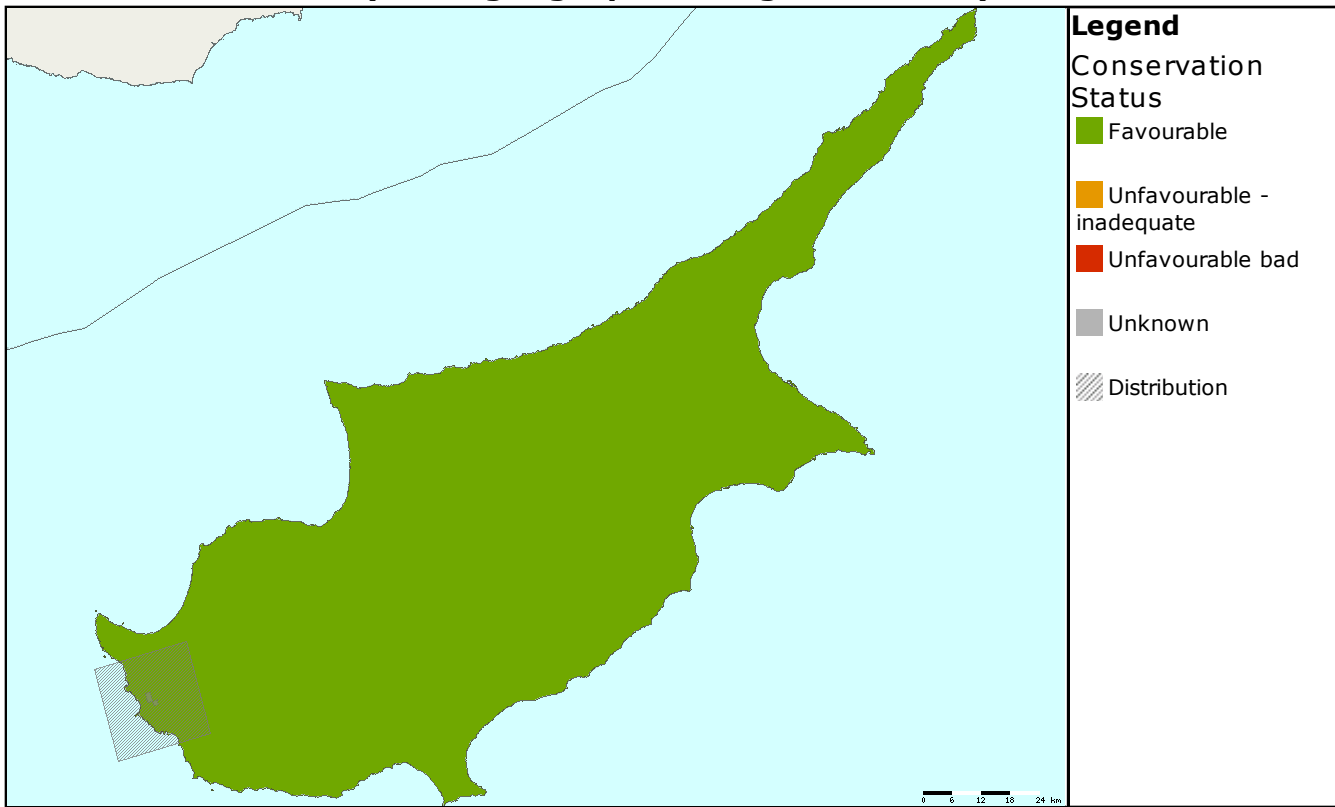

MED: Endemic to CY where only known from 2 sites on the Akamis peninsula. Cypriot NGOs report that the habitat is being destroyed (there are currently no SCI for this species) which suggests that future prospects are unfavourable. A value of 590 individuals as a favourable reference population appears very low and only one of the two known populations is above the 250-500 individual minimum viable population reported by Cyprus. Noted as critically endangered by IUCN in 2006
