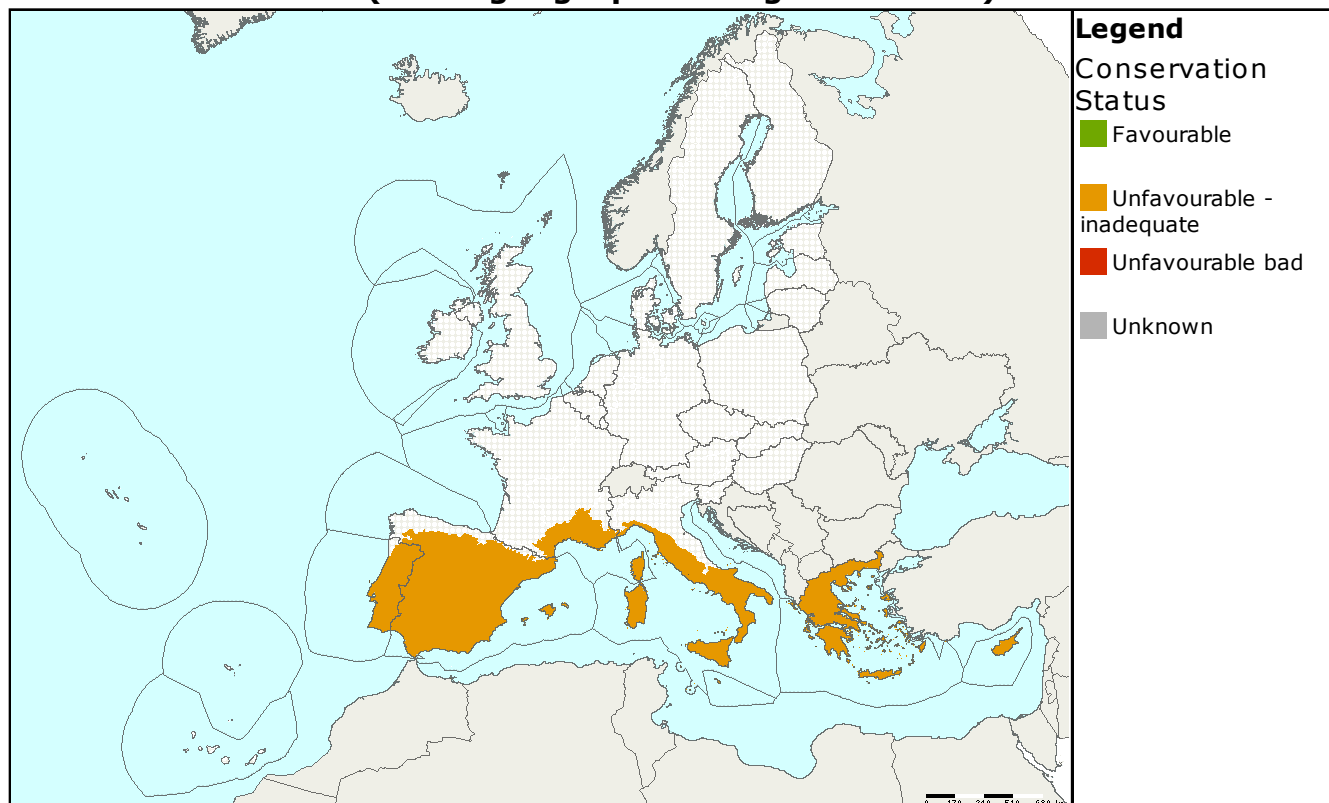

MED: Endemic to limestone rocks on Mt Timfristos, GR with 2 known populations
 Depending on the Ref value chosen for population may be 'bad' rather than poor Poorly known but considered 'poor', major threat is destruction of habitat by road construction & quarrying.
