



Colchicum arenarium is a flowering plant species of sandy grasslands. Major threats: abandonment of pastoral systems, artificial planting, roads, motorways, drying out / accumulation of organic material, invasion by a species, forestry clearance. It is reported from Pannonian region by Hungary and Slovakia. The overall assessment `unfavourableinadequate' is affected mostly by the Hungarian report. The Slovakian assessment is rather negative but has minor impact.
