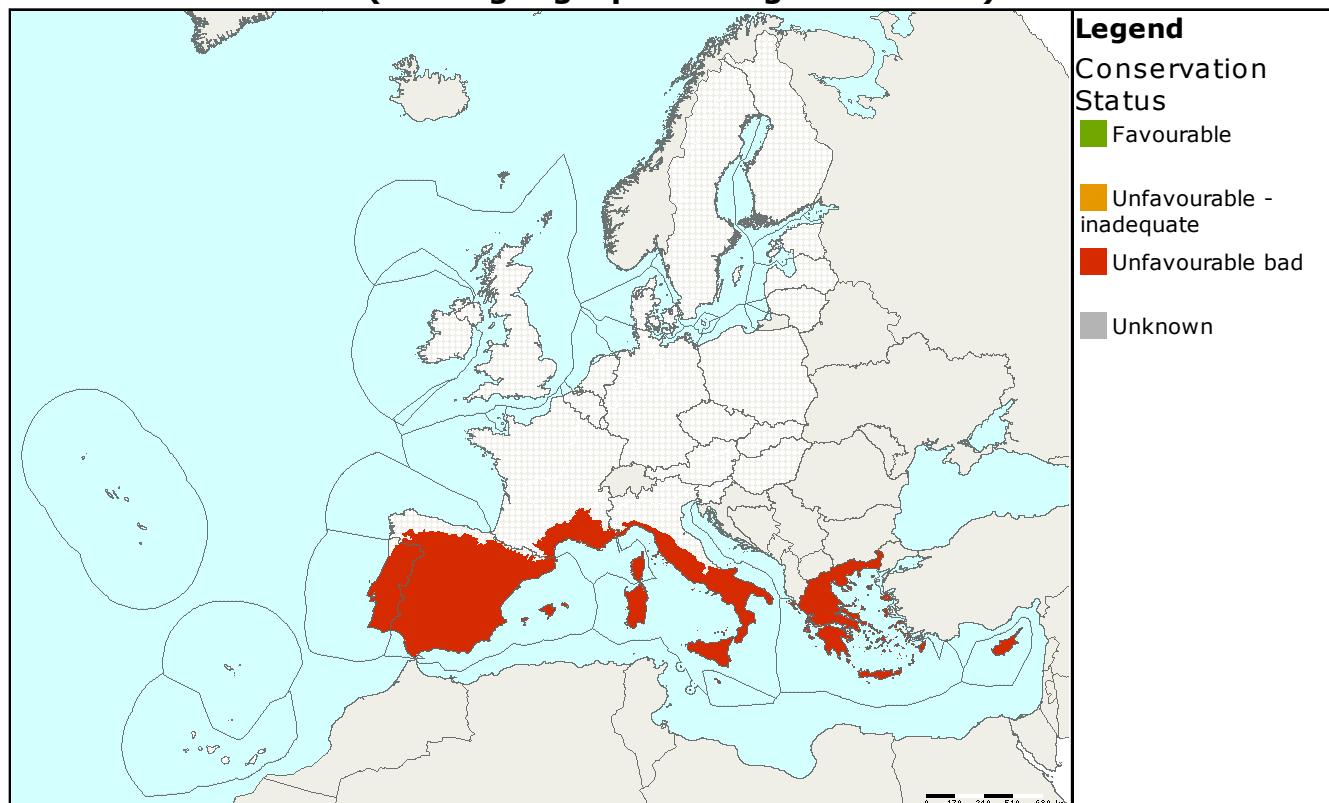

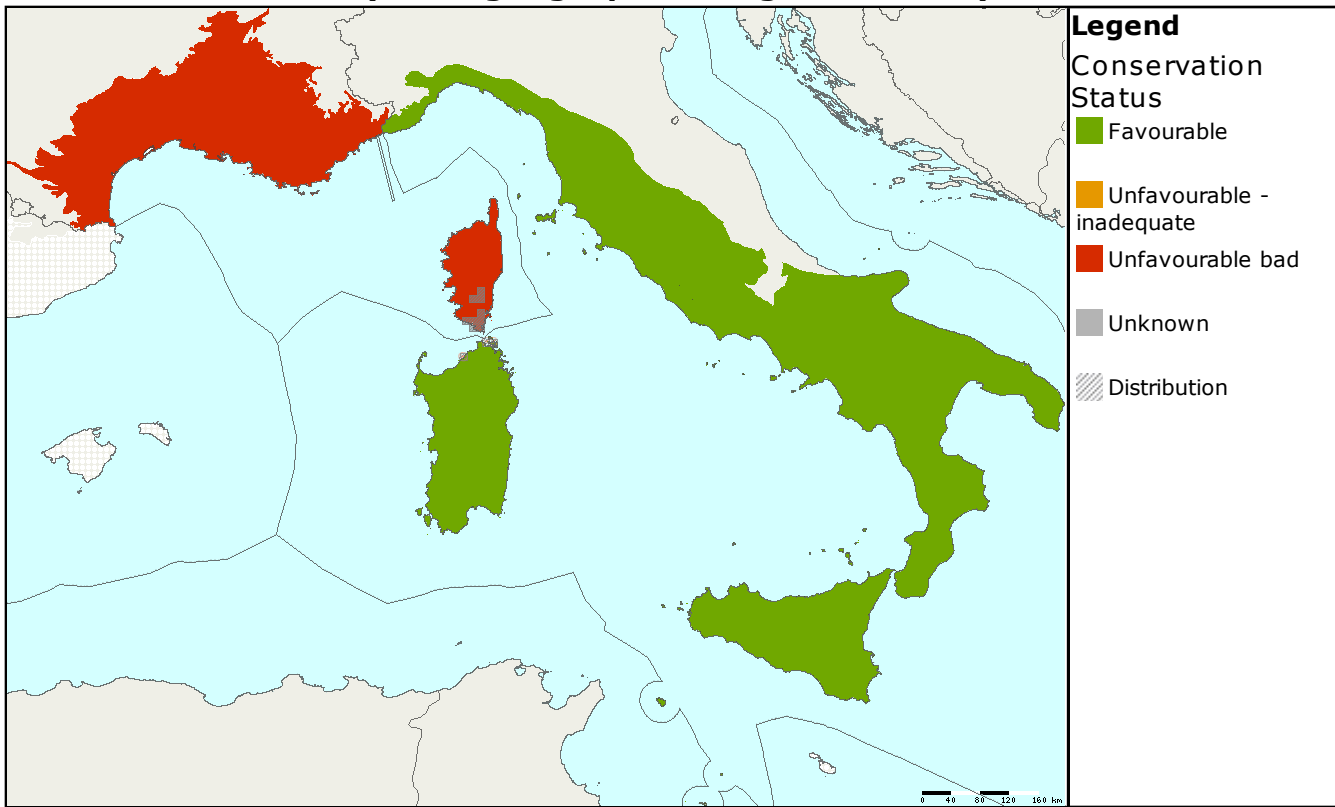

*Colchicum corsicum* is a flowering plant endemic to Sardinia (Italy) and Corsica (France). Major threats: dispersed habitation, motorised vehicles, hunting, fishing or collecting activities and tourism impacts. The regional assessment is 'unfavourable-bad' equaling the French report. The Italian assessment is rather positive but has minor impact.
