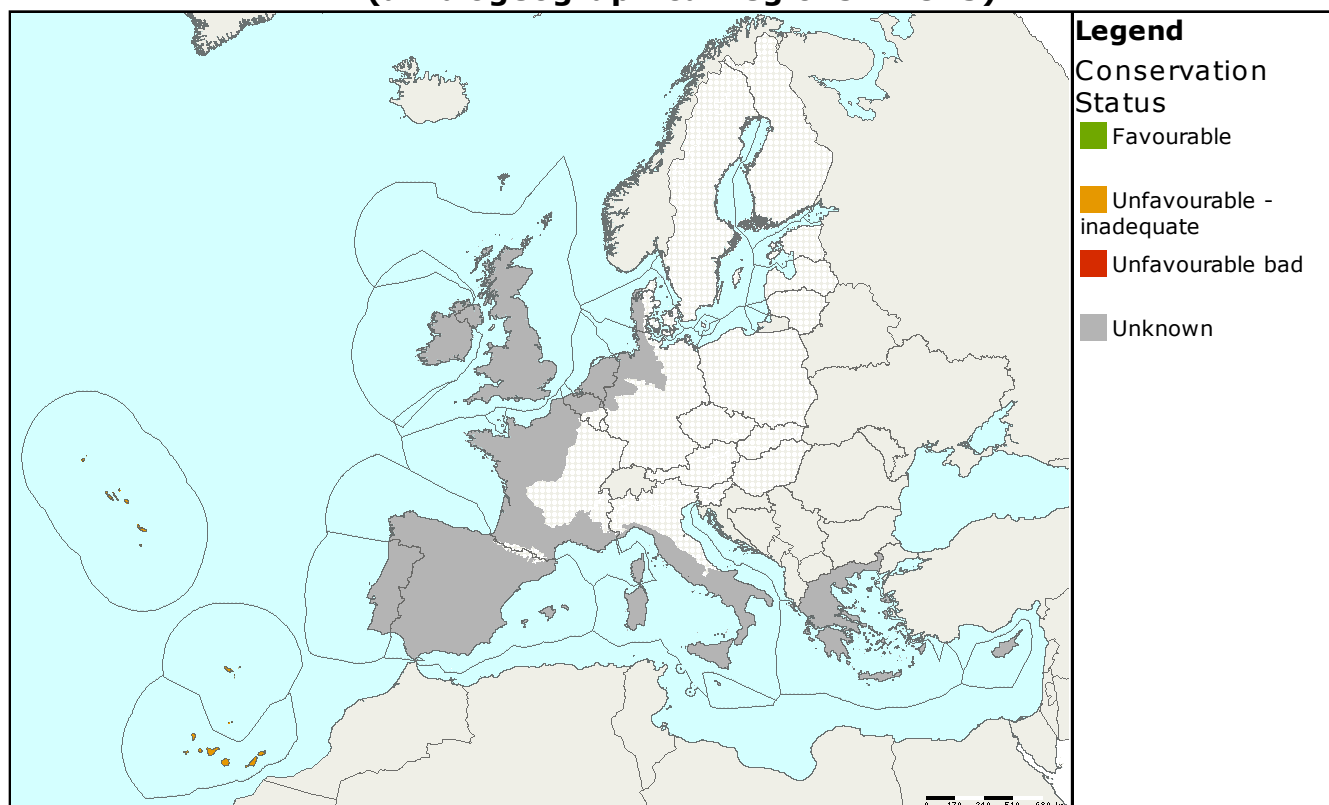

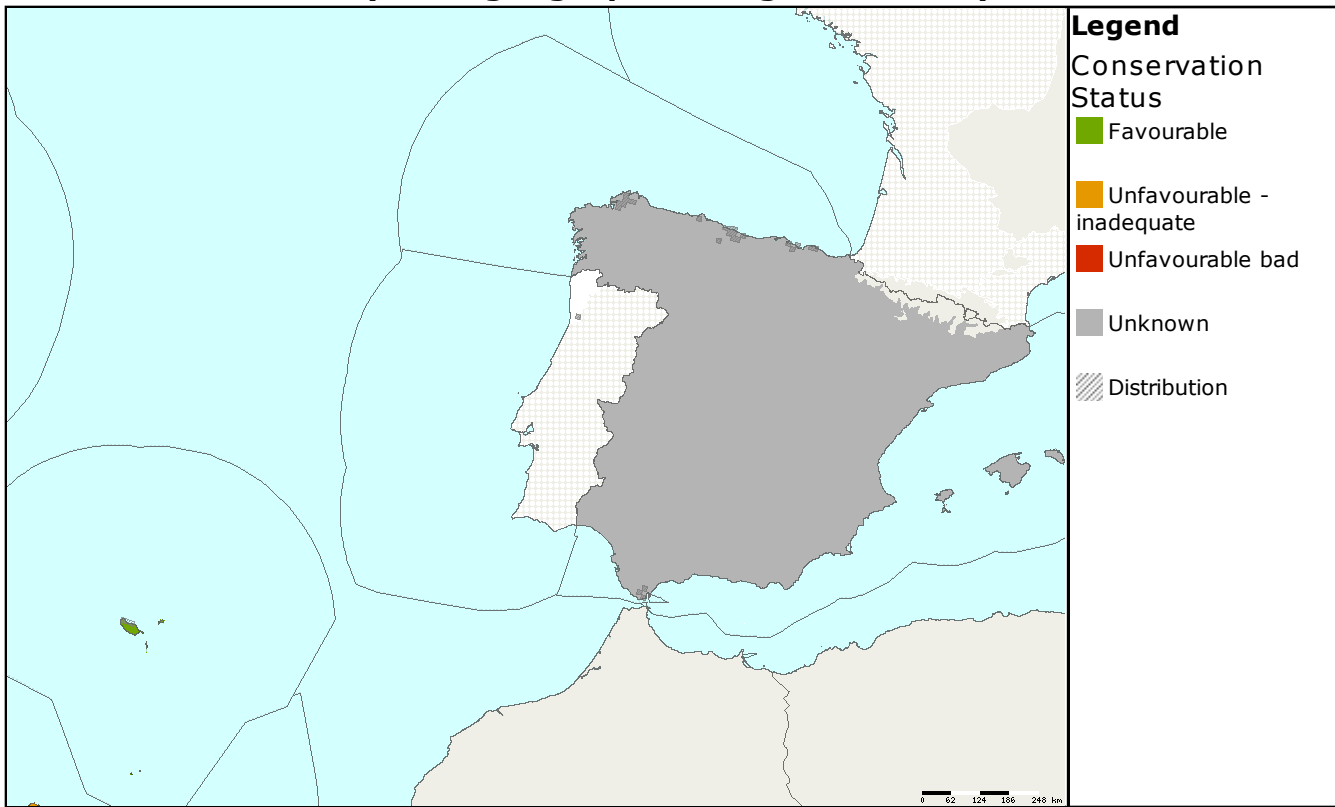

Culcita macrocarpa is a fern species which is found in Spain, Portugal and other parts of the Macaronesian region.

In all biogeographical regions this plant occurs (Atlantic, Macaronesian and Mediterranean) the overall status was assessed as ‘unknown’ or ‘inadequate’. A considerable amount of its Macaronesian range is situated in Portugal, which is the only area for which the status is reported as ‘favourable’. Many data from the only two countries (Portugal and Spain) in these regions are lacking and more is required.
