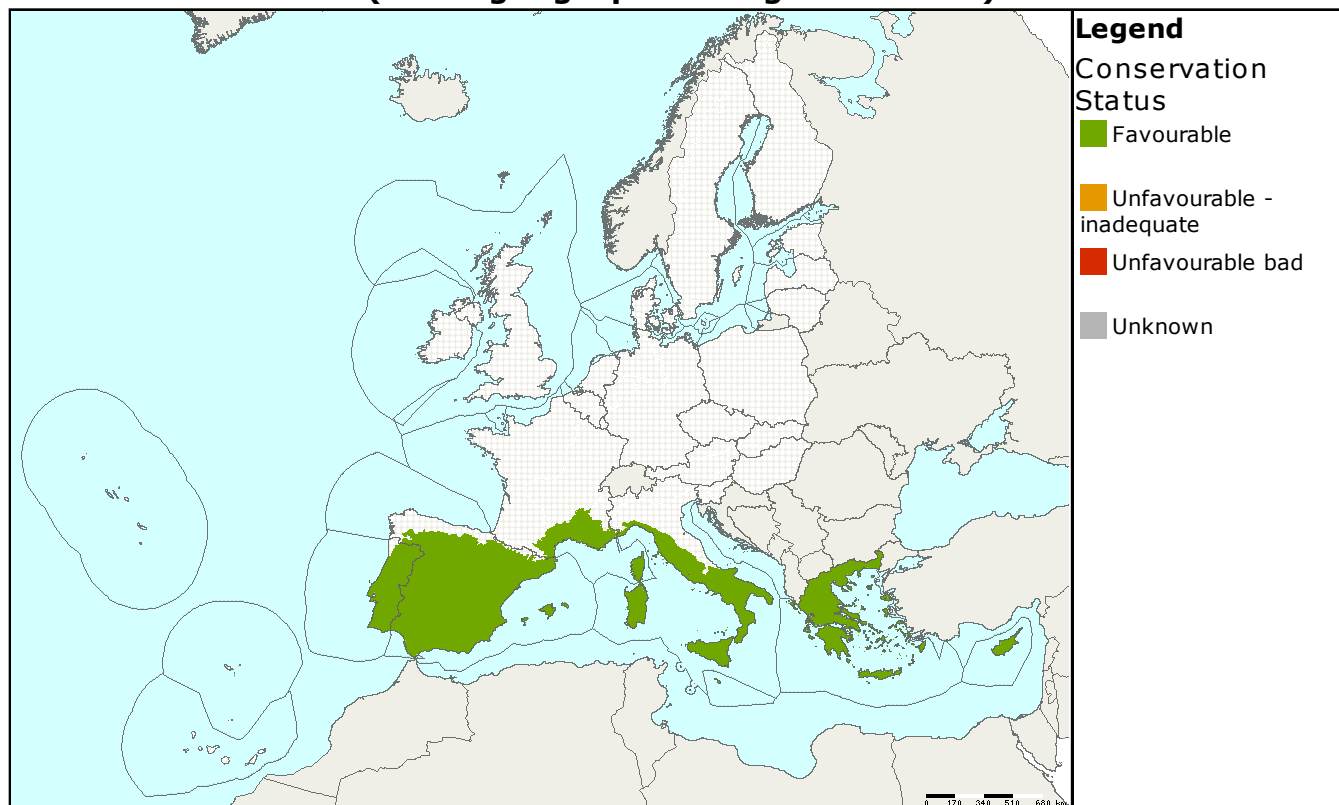

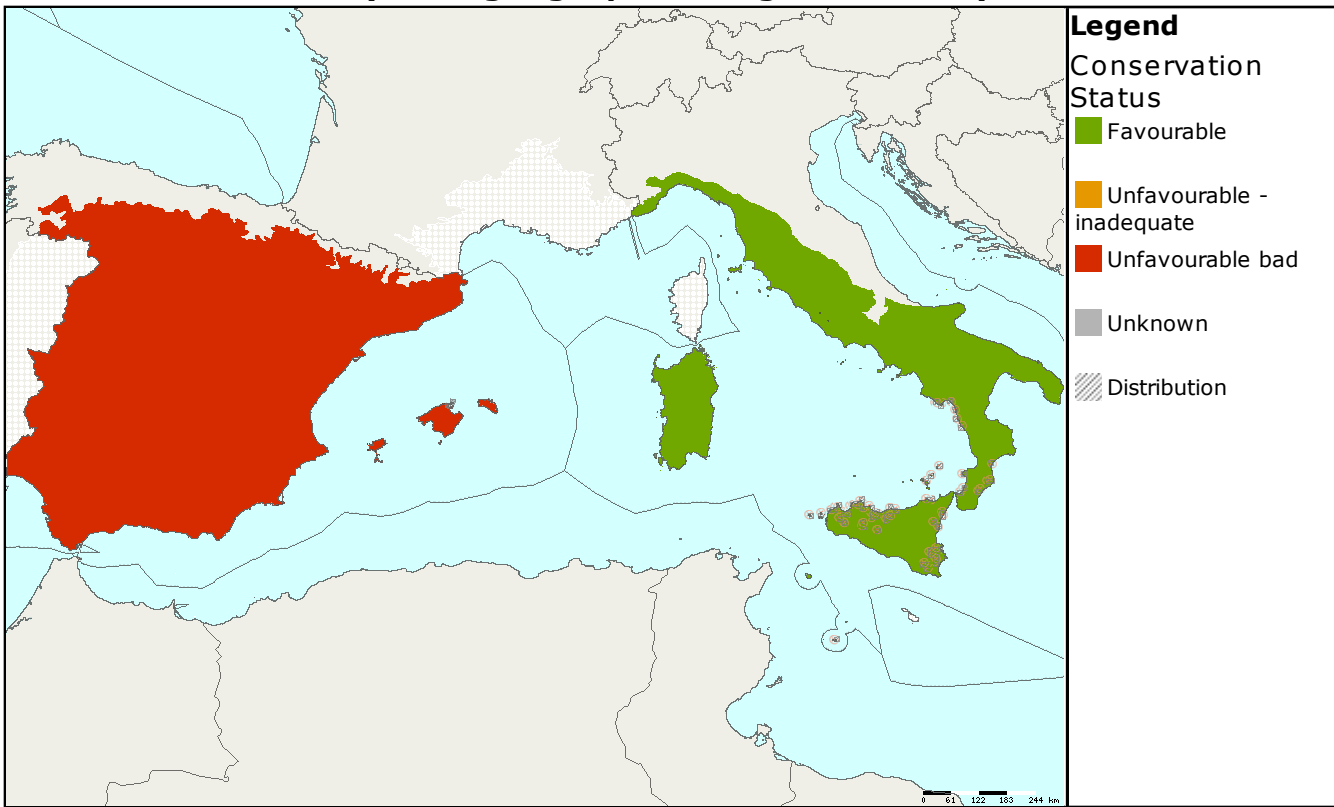

Dianthus rupicola is a flowering plant occurring in Mediterranean biogeographical region: southern Italy, particularly Sicily, Mallorca (Spain), but also in North Africa. It is assessed as 'favourable' although the small population in Mallorca (the endemic ssp *Dianthus rupicola* Biv. subsp. *bocchoriana*) is considered 'unfavourable-bad' for all parameters.
