



Euphrasia genargentea is a flowering plant reported from Mediterranean biogeographical region by France and Italy (Corsica and Sardinia), with majority of its distribution in Corsica. The overall assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate' affected mostly by the French report ('favourable' prevailing, but 'unfavourable-inadequate' in future prospect parameter). Italian report has the same 'unfavourable-inadequate' conclusion.
