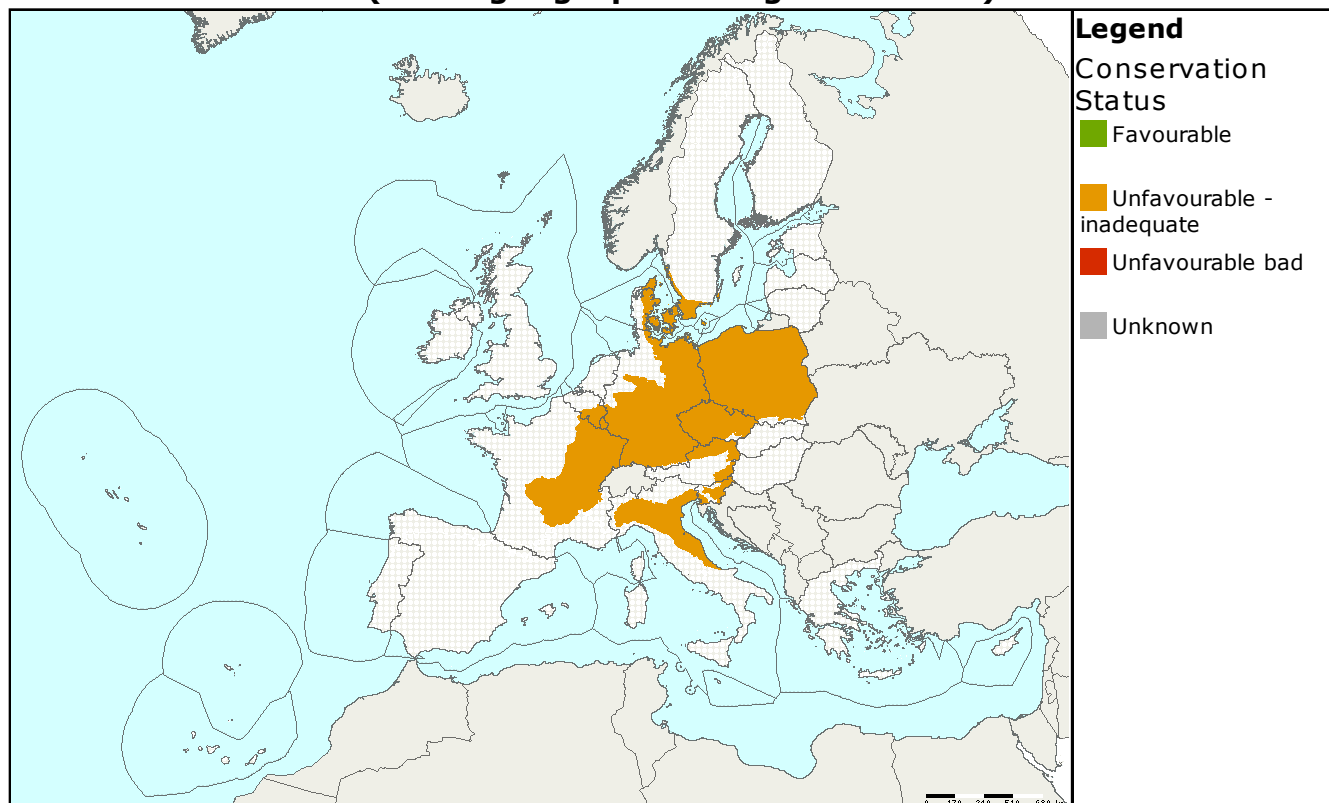

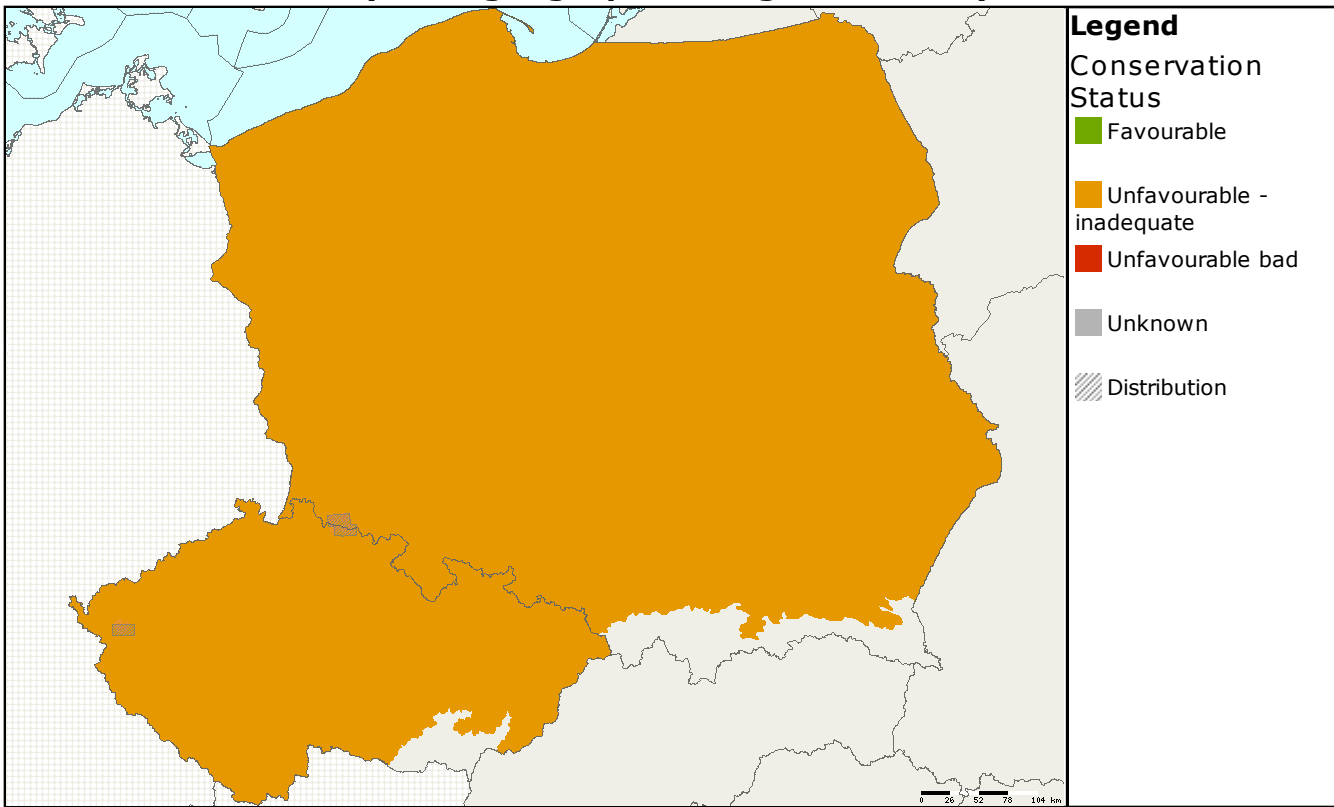

Galium sudeticum is a flowering plant endemic to the Krkonoše Mountains and to serpentine in western Bohemia. It is reported from Continental region by Czech Republic and Poland. Although range and population are considered 'favourable', overall assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate' due to habitat and future prospects parameters. Some of the reported data is inconsistent but this does not alter the overall assessment. Better information would help give a better assessment.
