



A plant species endemic to the French and Italian Maritime and Ligurian Alps. It is a species of calcareous cliffs and mountain grasslands on rocky slopes and shallow skeletal soils. Occasionally it penetrates into open light mainly pine forests.

The conservation status in both the Alpine and the Mediterranean biogeographical region is 'favourable'. The range and the population size are stable and no major threats to the species and its habitats were recorded. In Italy the species is included in the national red list under the category 'least concern'. It is collected for the preparation of liqueurs, what may represent a potential threat.
