



A rare stockrose (Helianthemum caput-felis) is known only from Mediterranean region, Alicante and the Balearic Iles (Spain) and Sardinia (Italy). Greatest threaten is habitat destruction. It is assessed as 'unfavourable-bad' for all parameters in Spain, which hosts the most of total population. Overall assessment is therefore the same. Italian assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate'.
