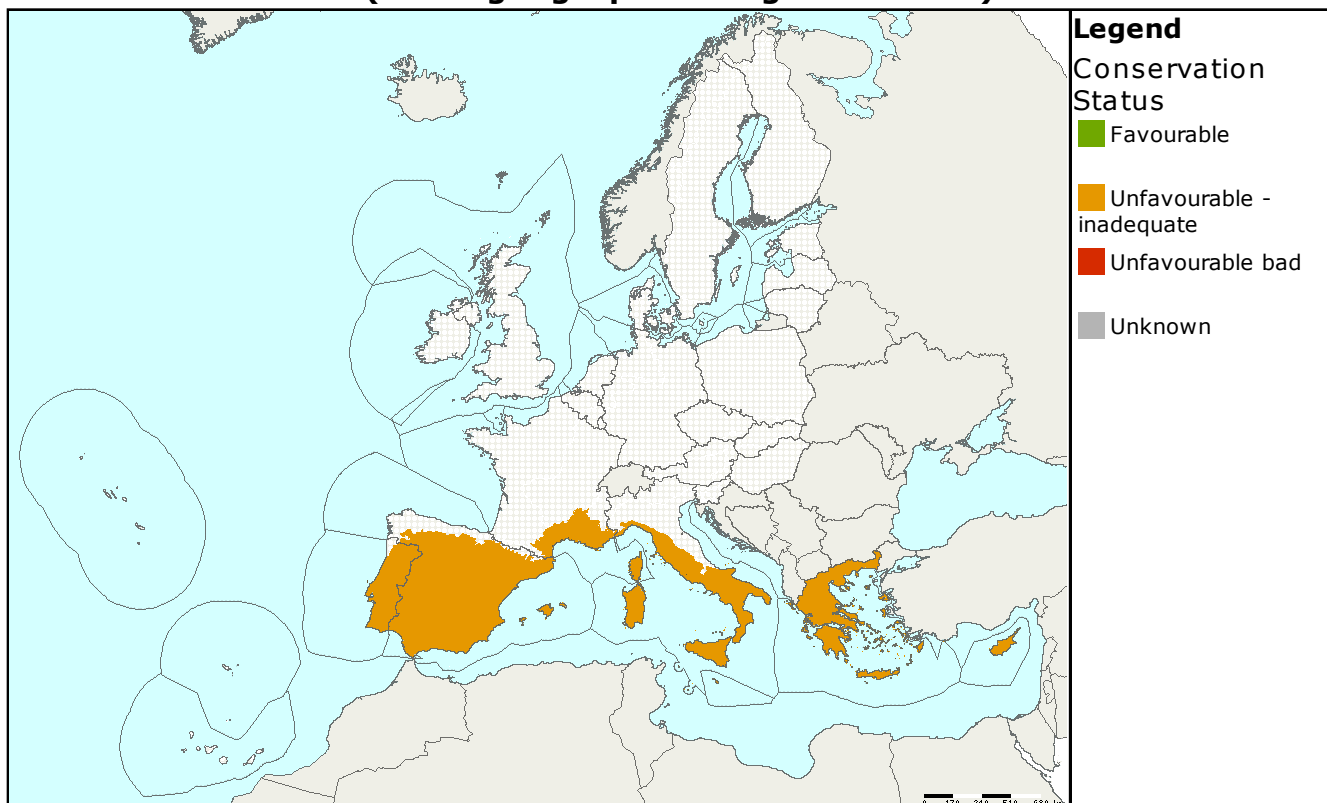

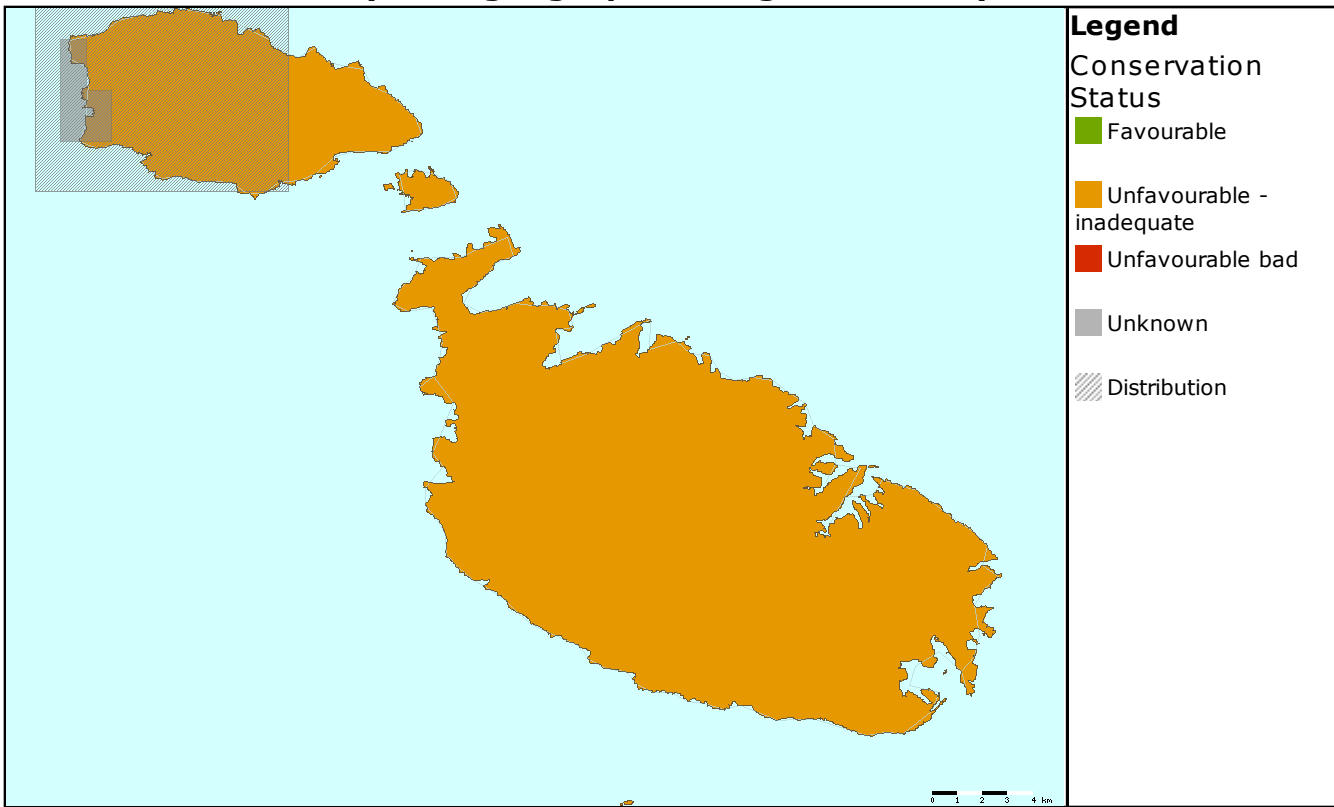

MED: Endemic to seacliffs in western Gozo (Malta), previously also known from the island of Malta but not seen since 1927 Threats are habitat destruction, either natural (eg erosion) or by man (eg quarrying).
