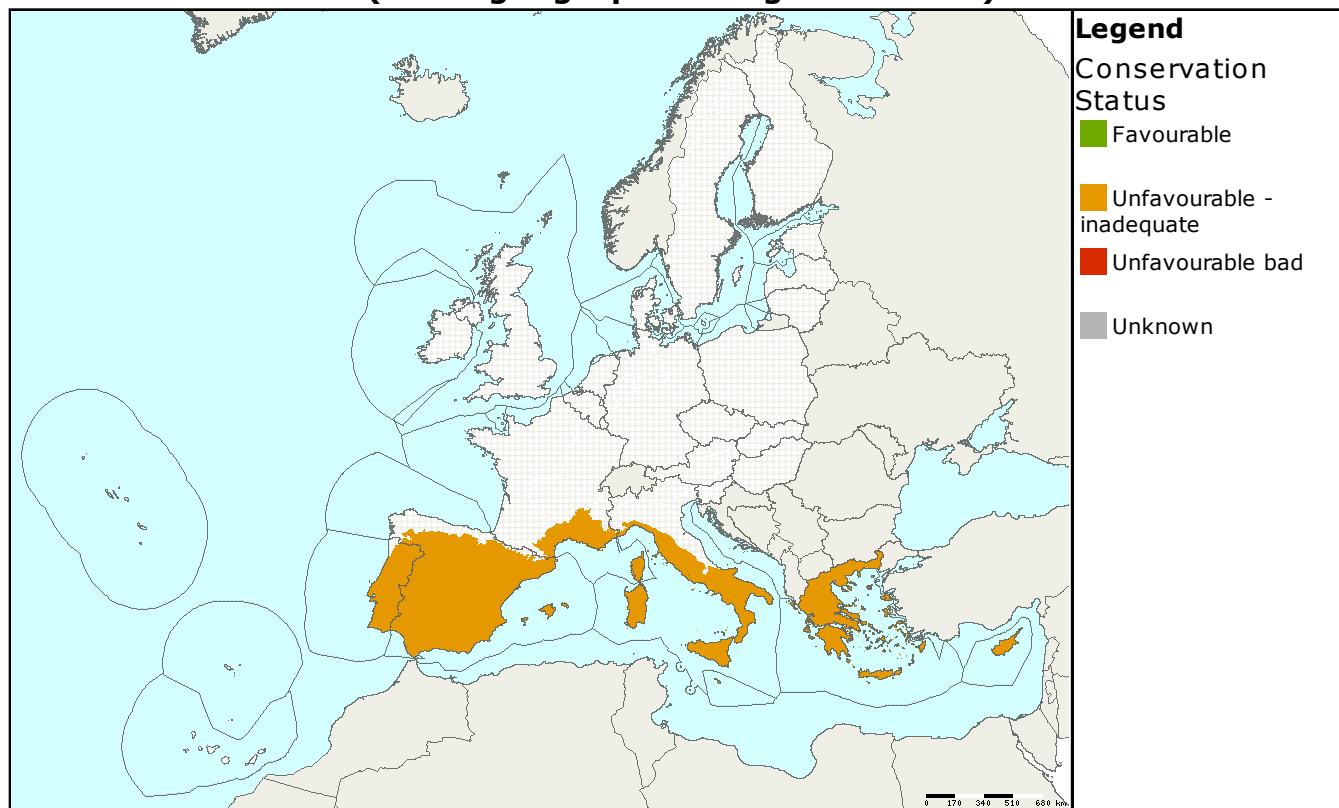

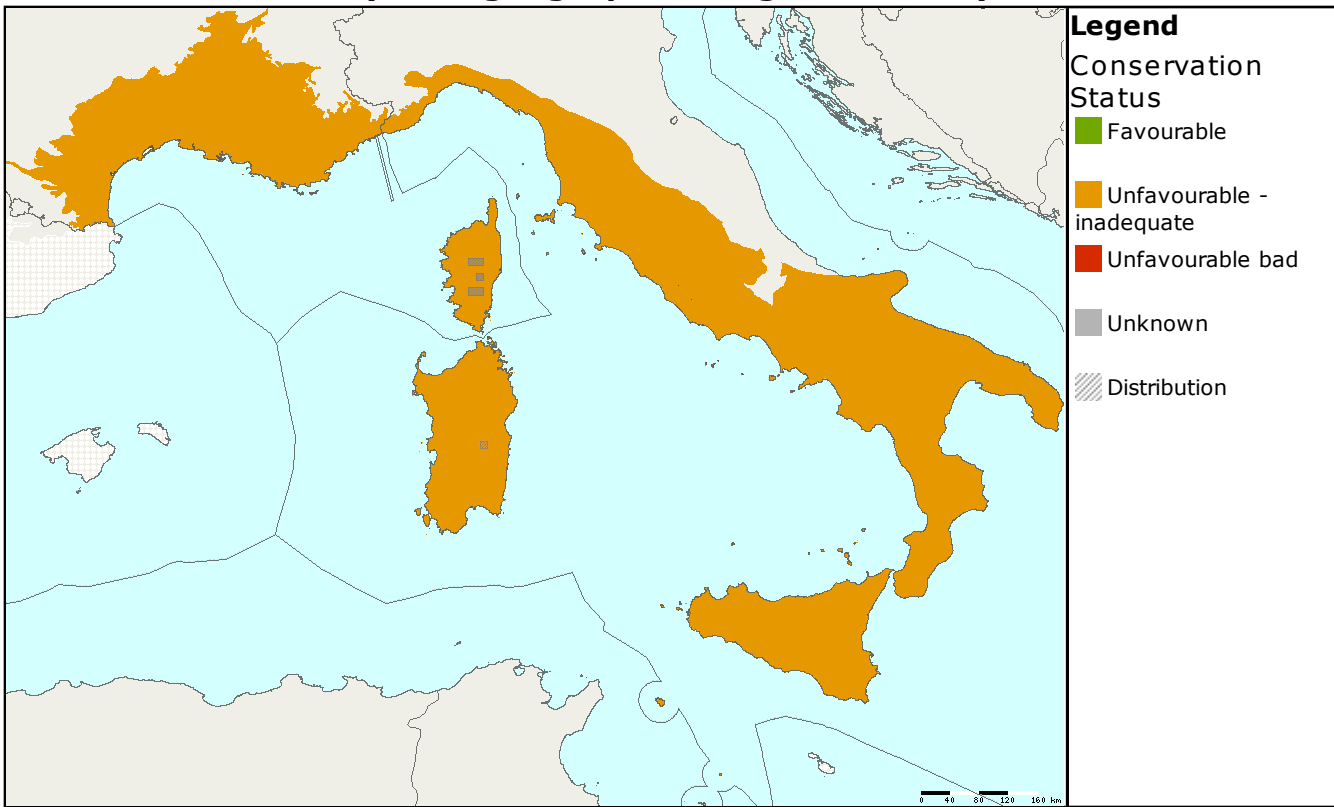

Herniaria latifolia ssp. Litardierei is a plant endemic to Mediterranean islands of Corsica (France) and Sardinia (Italy). There is only one known population in Sardinia and seven in Corsica. In France only 'future prospects' are not considered 'favourable' due to pressures from inappropriate land use. Overall assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate' which is the same as both national conclusions.
