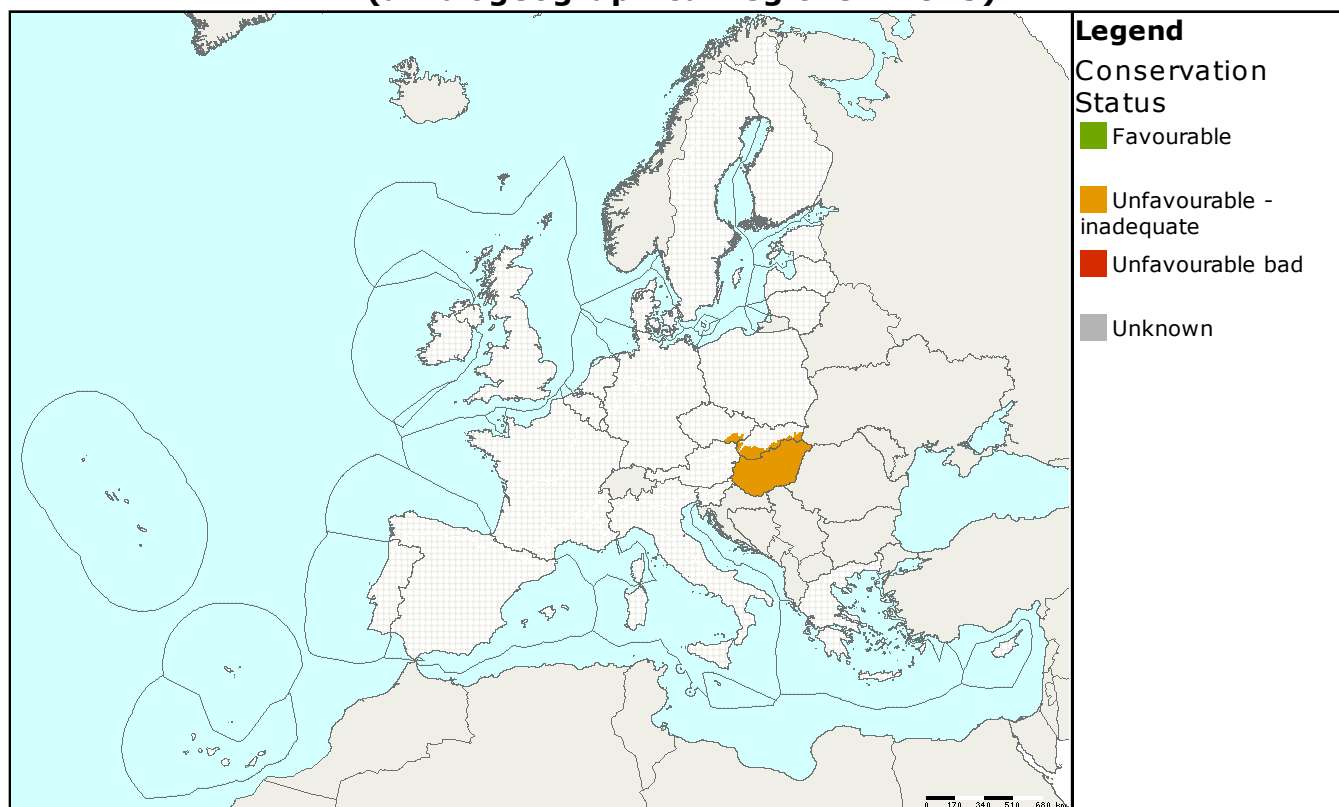

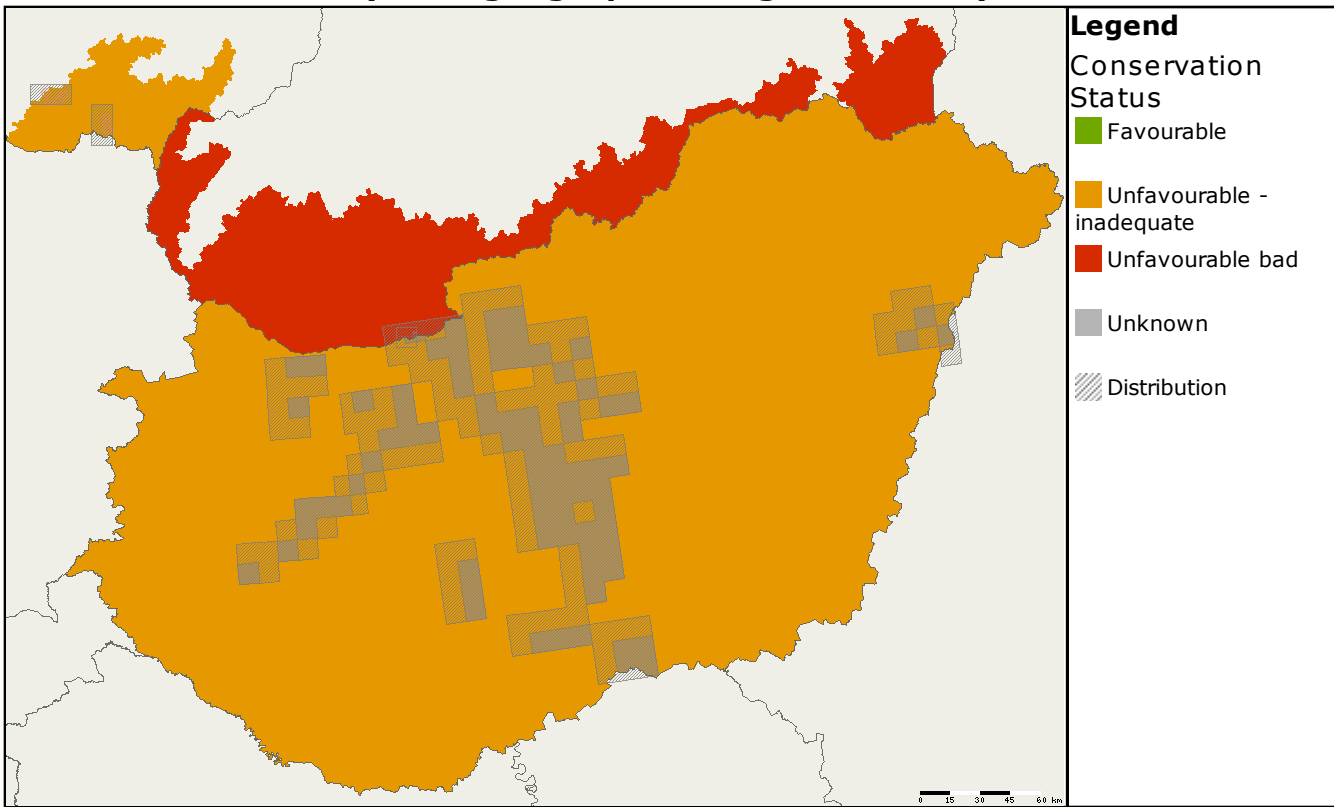

Iris humilis ssp. arenaria is a flowering plant species distributed across whole Pannonian region with almost whole population in Hungary. Overall conclusion is 'unfavourable-inadequate' due to the same conclusion on population and future prospects. 'Unfavourable-bad' status in Slovakia relates to a very small distribution of the species therefore the conclusions on range and habitat can be 'favourable'.
