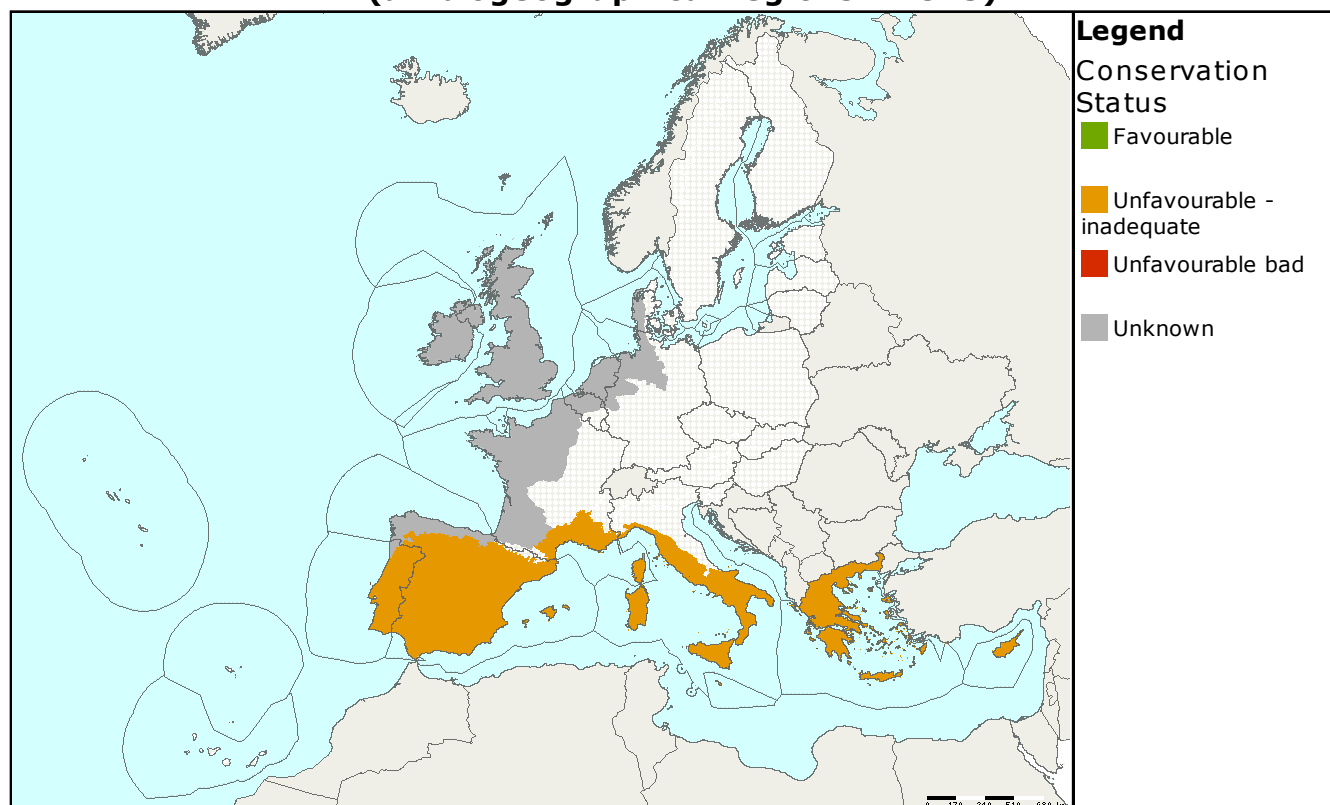

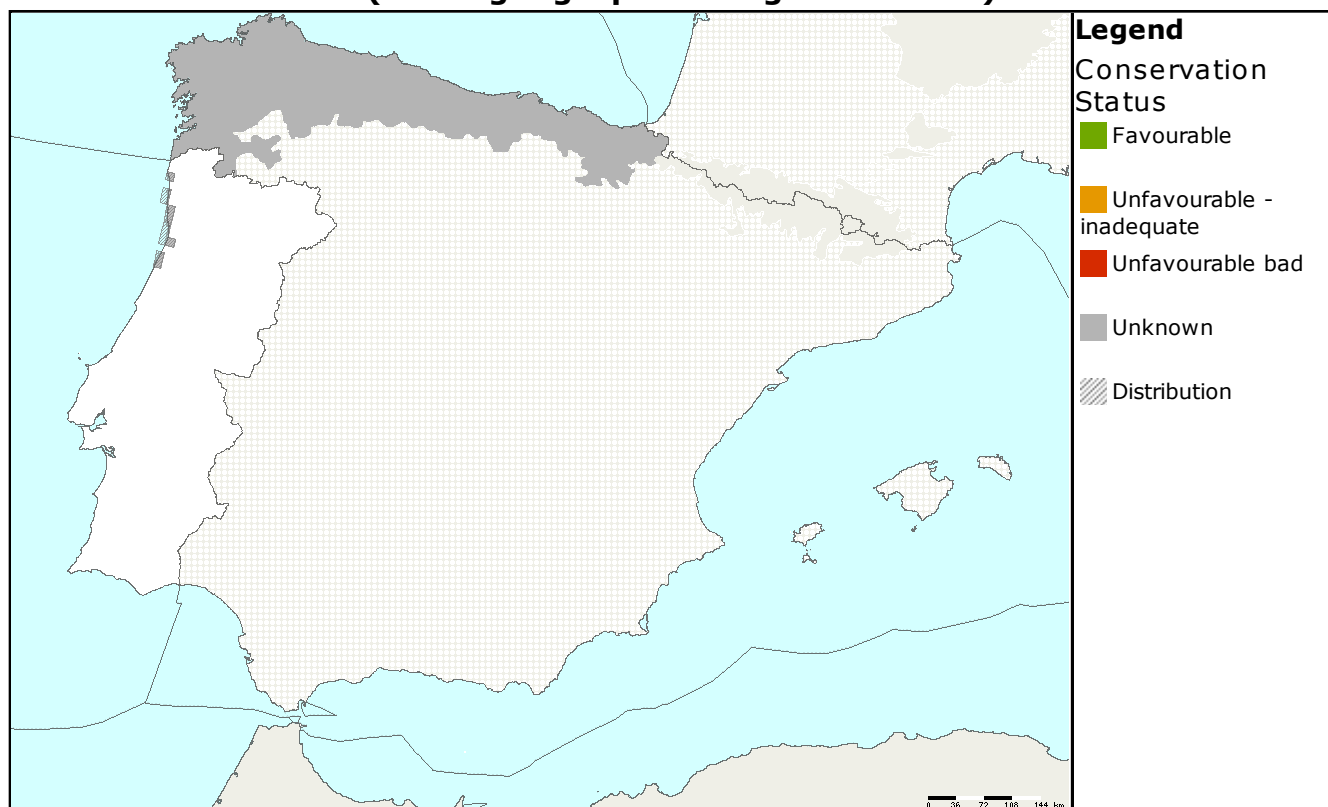

Plant species endemics to the Iberian Peninsula. It occurs only along the north-western Iberian coast. It is a species of sand dunes and inter-dunal depression. It prefers secondary dunes and other stands with stabilised substrate. On the other hand it occurs mostly in an open vegetation.

The reports for this, in general very poorly known, species are incomplete. The conservation status was not assessed at the national level in Portugal. The gaps in data do not allow other than 'unknown' conclusion for the Atlantic biogeographical region. Regarding the Mediterranean biogeographical region Future prospects are poor, which leads to 'unfavourable inadequate' assessment of this parameter and further of the overall conservation status. However better information is required in order to make a comprehensive assessment. This species is considered vulnerable in Portugal.
