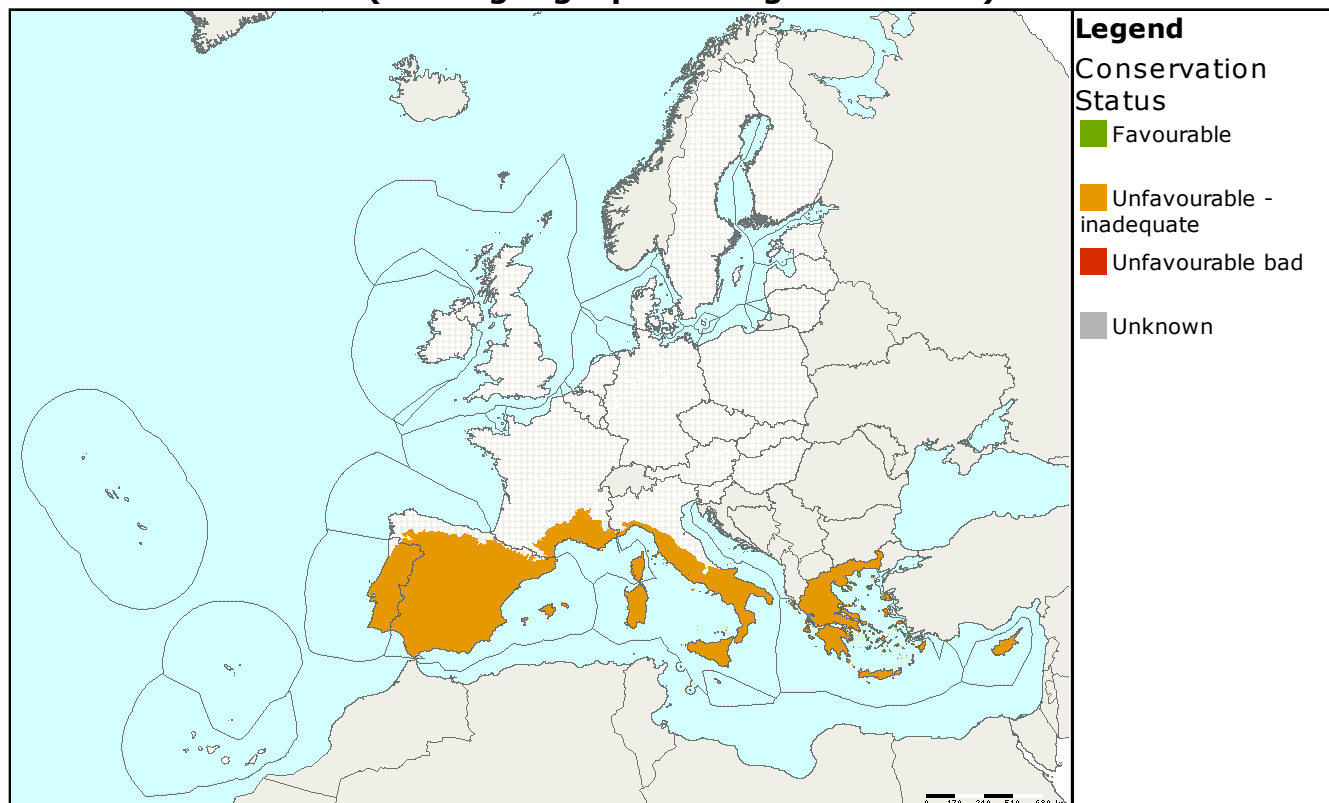

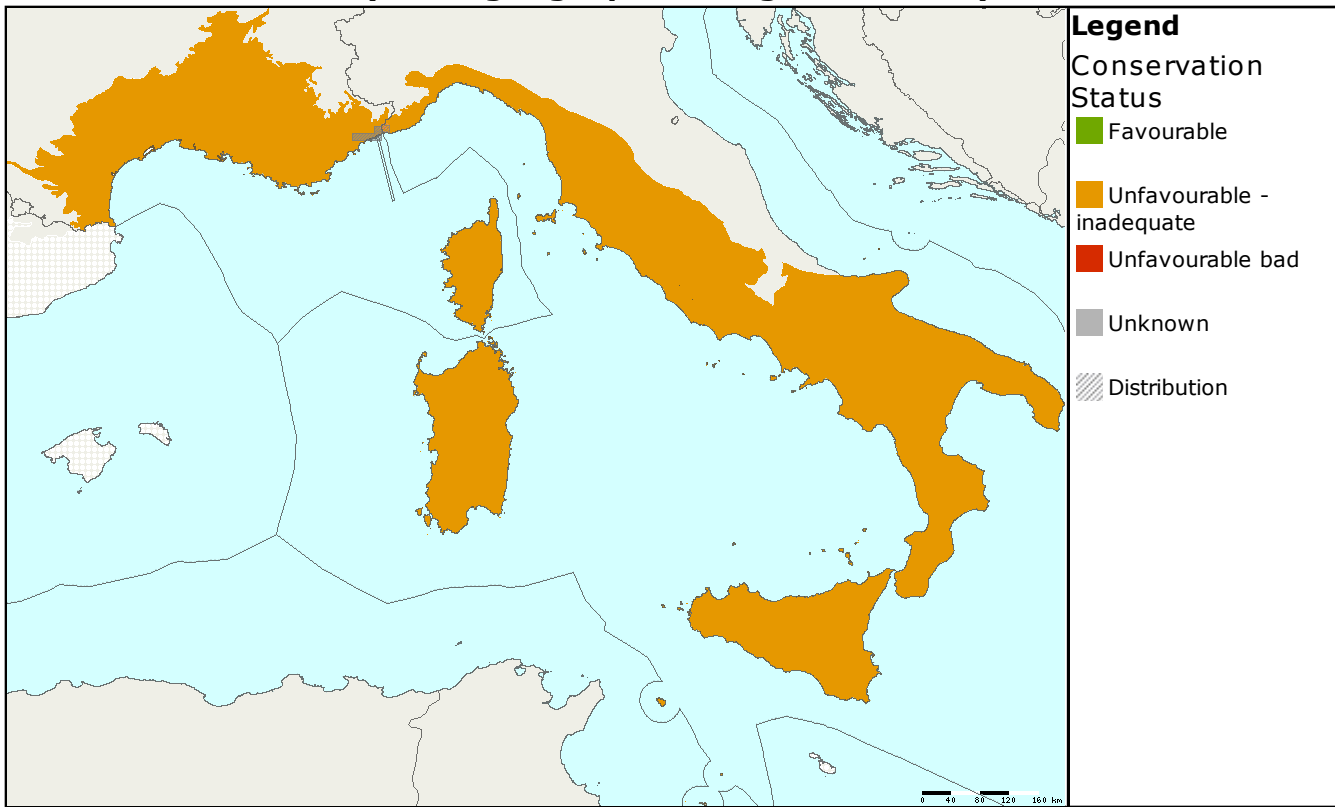

Leucojum nicaeense is a flowering plant species reported only from a restricted area close to the Fench/Italian border and the sea. France hosts the major part of the population in this region. Overall conclusion is 'inadequate' due to such status of the habitat and future prospects parameters. No 'favourable' parameter was reported by Italy either.
