



Linaria flava is a plant species reported from Mediterranean region by France and Italy (islands of Corsica and Sardinia). Major threats: erosion, motorised vehicles, continuous urbanisation, leisure and tourism impacts. Despite of prevailing 'favourable' values, the decisive factor for the 'unfavourable-bad' overall assessment is rather negative assessment of habitat and future prospects parameters in French report. Italian report is 'favourable'.
