



Marsilea batardae is a fern endemic to Iberian Peninsula, growing in water habitats. The overall assessment for Mediterranean region is 'unknown but not favourable'. There is very little information reported by both Spain and Portugal. Overall assessment could also be 'unfavourable – inadequate' (indicated by Portugal) or 'unfavourable – bad' according to future prospects in Spain. Better information required.
