



Marsilea strigosa is a fern species reported from Mediterranean region by Spain, France and Italy. Partial conclusions and overall regional conclusion is 'unknown' due to such status of all parameters reported from Spain, hosting 87.1% of species distribution. Neither 'unfavourable-inadequate' status of Italian range, population and future prospects, nor French 'unfavourable-bad' status of habitat and future prospects are sufficient to change the conclusion. Better information required by Spain.
