



Moehringia lateriflora is a flowering plant with circumpolar distribution including Russia, China, Japan and North America. Within the European Union it is very rare in Estonia and Sweden, more widespread in Finland (Boreal region). Considered 'favourable' in Estonia and Sweden, but not in Finland which has the majority of the population (based on distribution). Overall assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate'.
