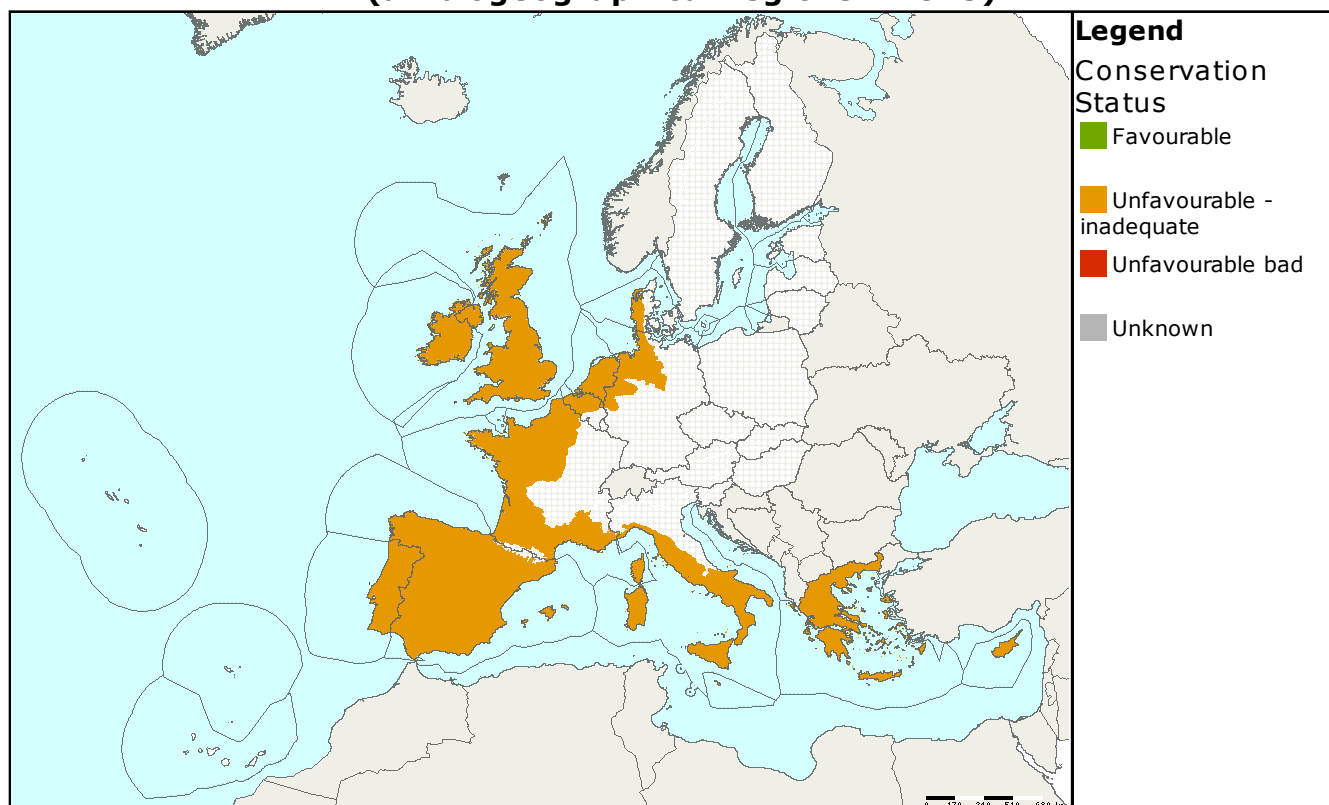

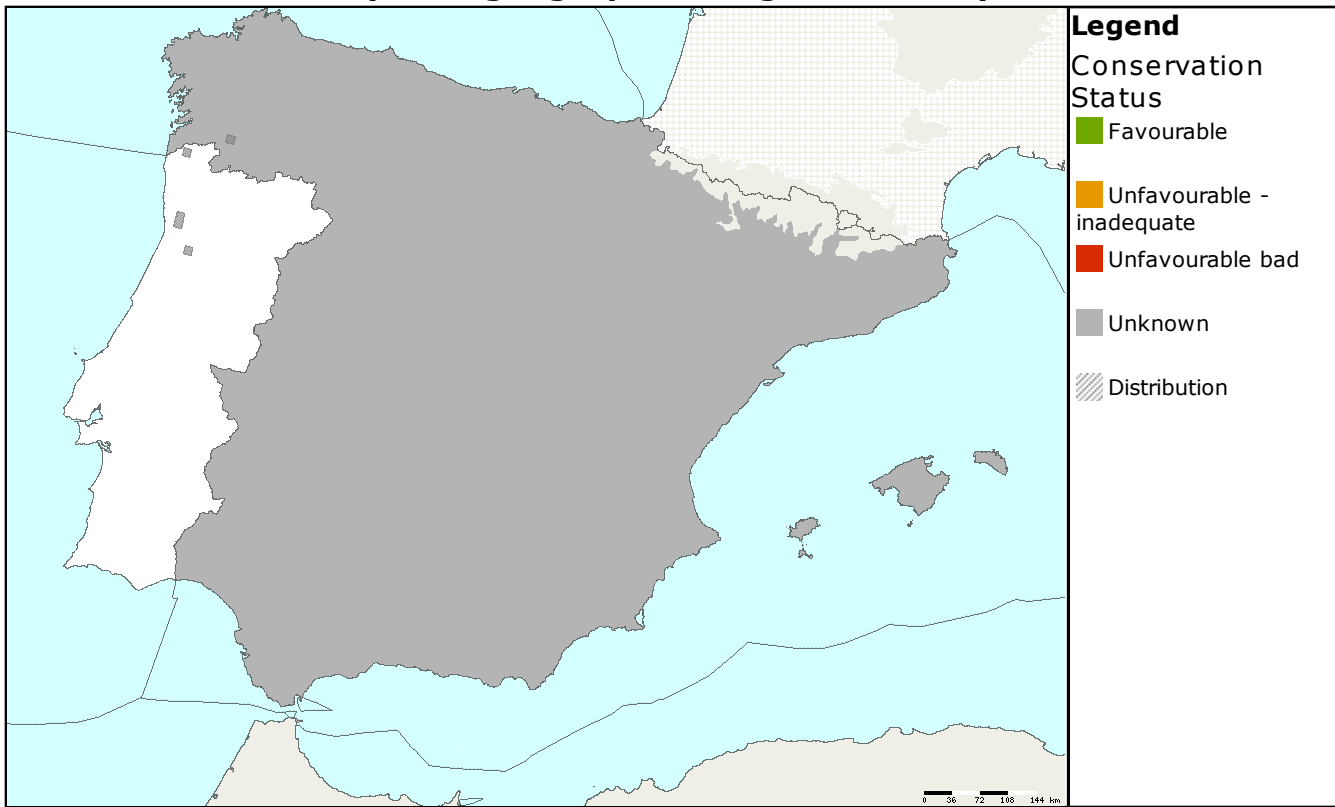

A plant species endemic to the north-western Iberian Peninsula. It occurs rarely in both Portugal and Spain. You can find this decorative species in fringe communities along water courses, in alluvial forests and sometimes in alluvial meadows. It prefers shaded stands with humid soils rich in nutrition.

The reports for this in general poorly known species are incomplete. Conservation status was not assessed at the national level in Portugal. The analysis of the data allows to conclude that Future prospects should be assessed as 'unfavourable inadequate' at the biogeographical level and other parameters are 'unknown' This leads to 'unfavourable inadequate' overall assessment. Like other species occurring along the rivers it is sensitive to a water pollution mainly due to agricultural activities.
