



This species was reported only from France. However it is relatively common in southern France and southern Spain. In France it occurs in upland stony grasslands on calcareous substrate, while in Spain it is a spring component of lowland garrigue and dry calcareous grasslands.

The conservation status in the Alpine biogeographical region is 'unfavourable inadequate' the range area and the population size are decreasing, which is a consequence of the succession changes of the vegetation after an abandonment of pasture. The conservation status in the Mediterranean biogeographical region is 'favourable', but this does not concern the situation in Spain.
