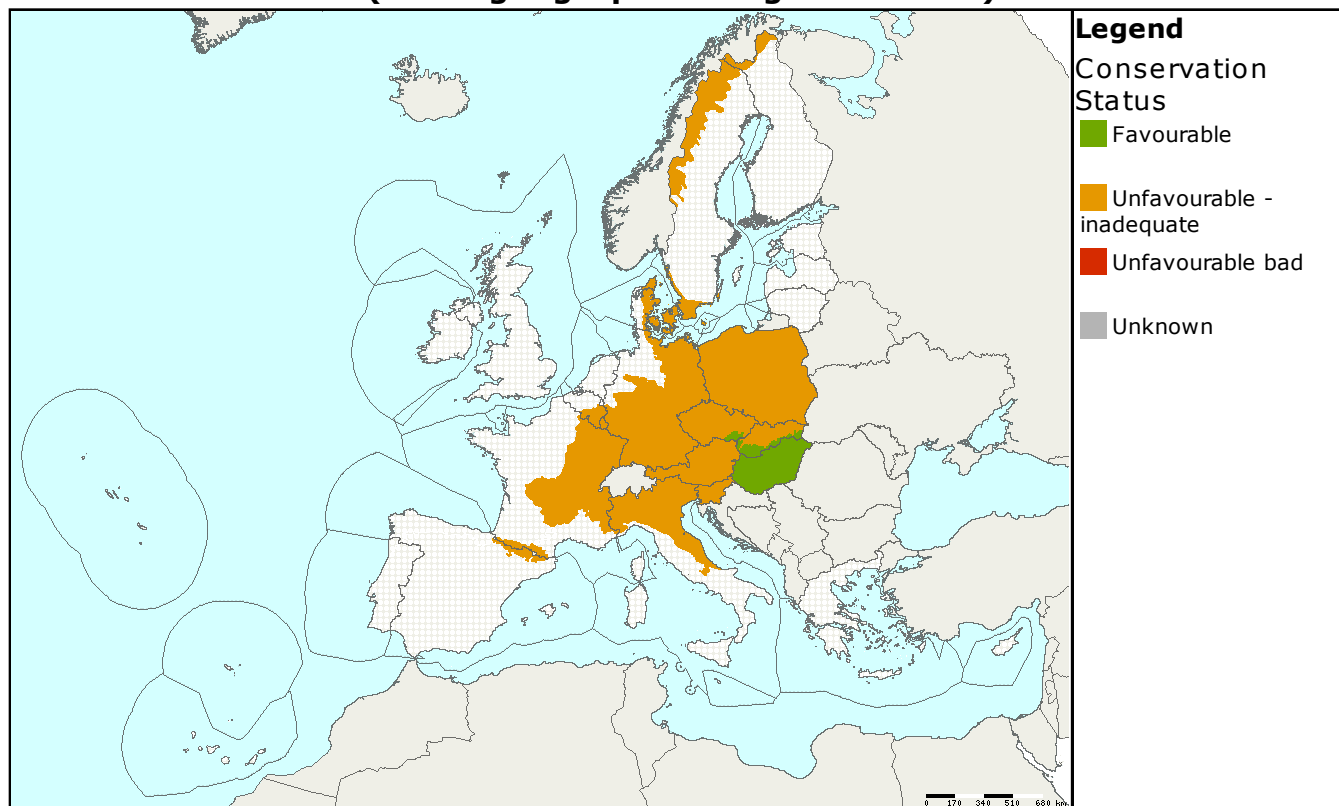

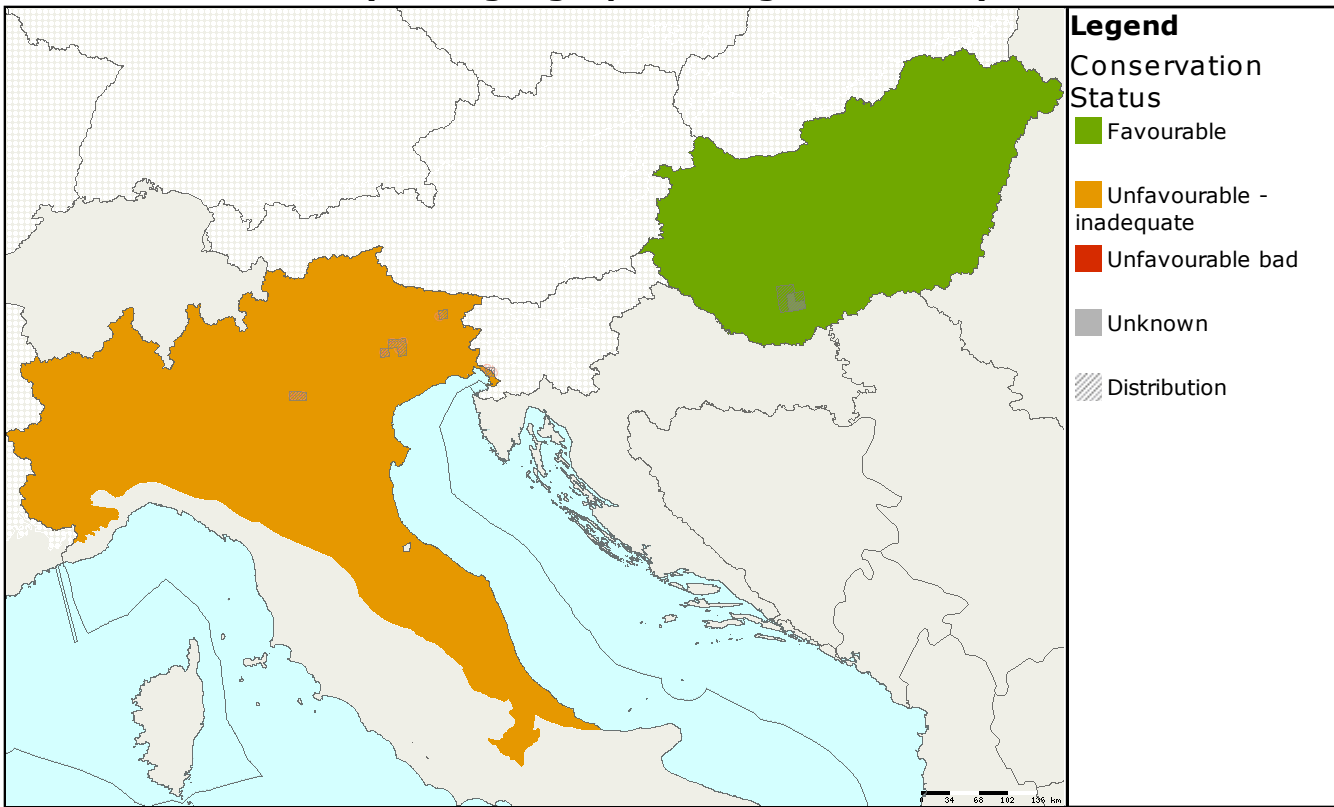

The *Paeonia officinalis* ssp. *banatica* is a flowering plant that occurs in north-eastern Italy and Hungary. The species is only reported by Italy for Alpine and Continental regions and its overall status of conservation is "unfavourable-inadequate", with data missing for habitat parameter. For Pannonian region only Hungary is reporting and the assessment is "favourable".
