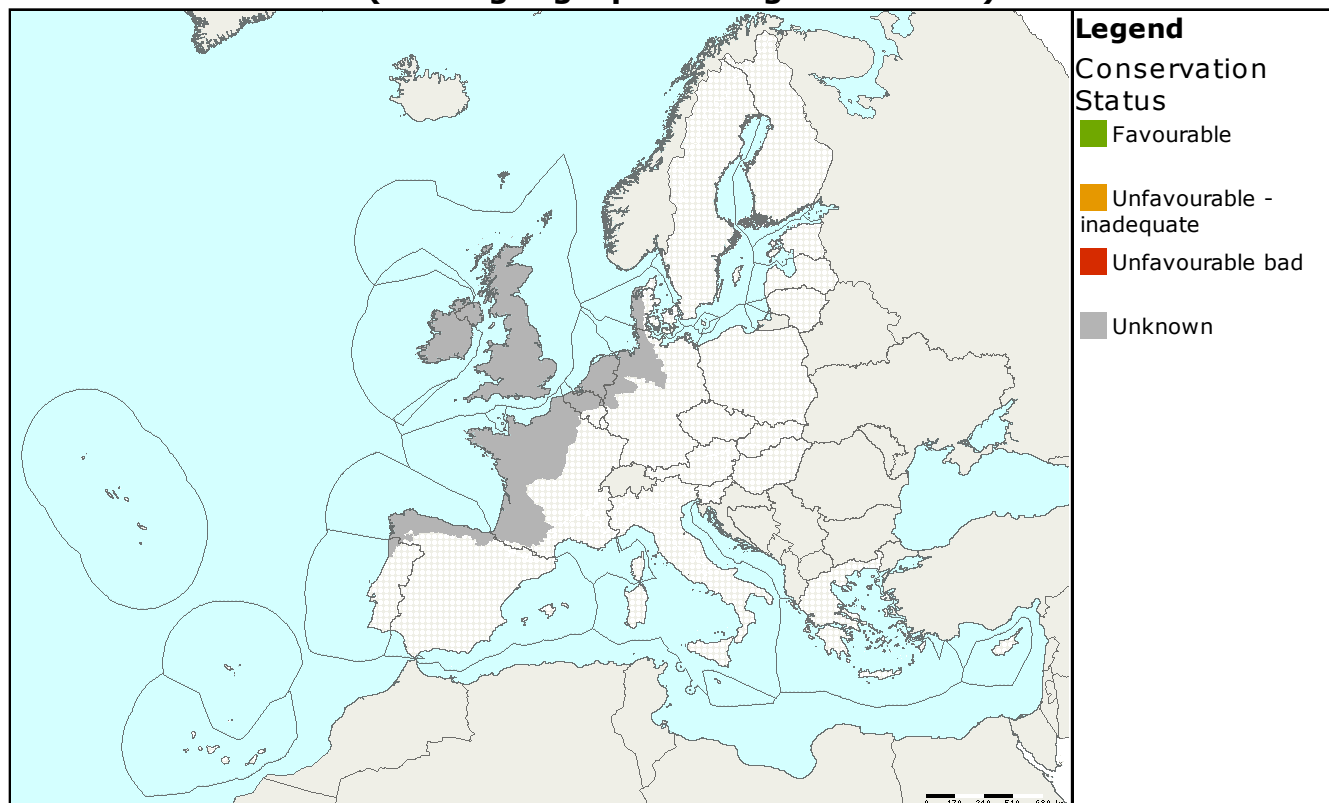

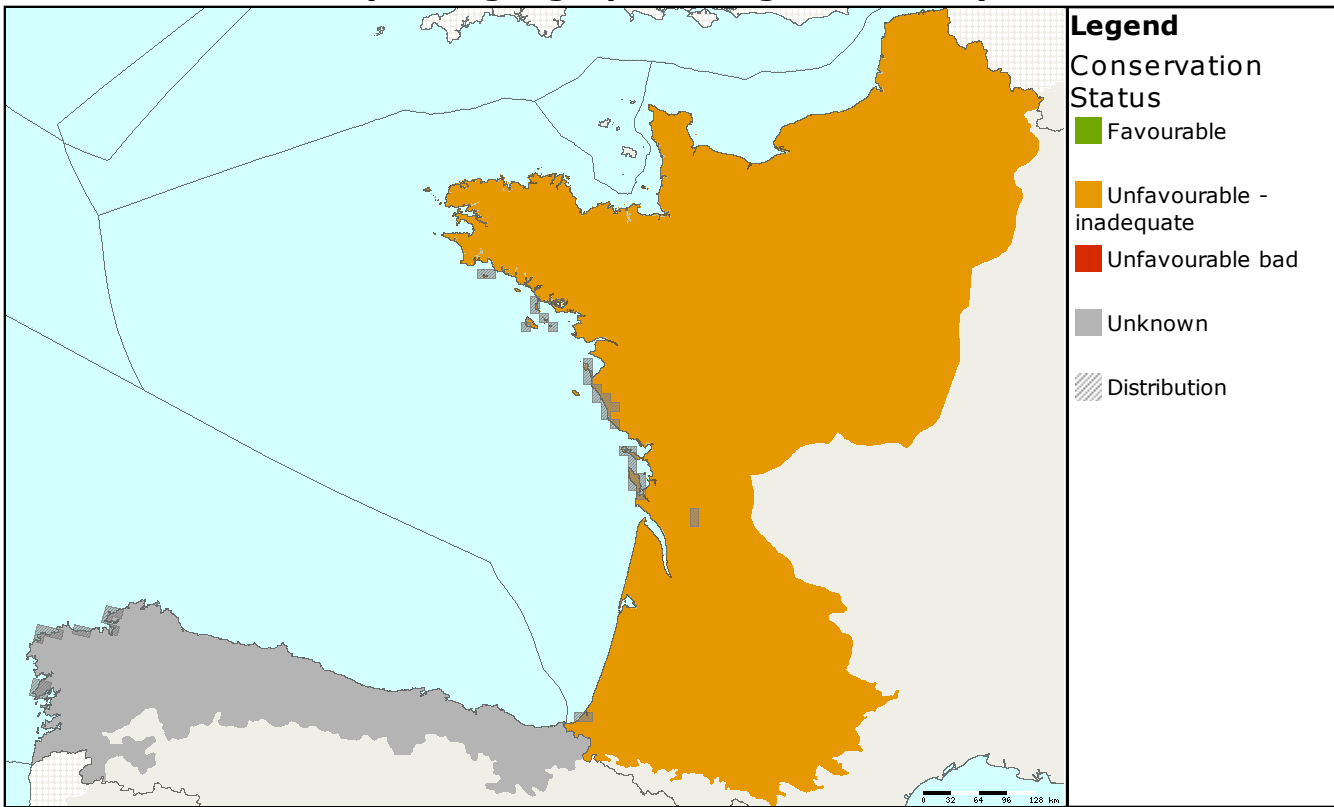

Omphalodes littoralis is a plant that occurs in the Atlantic region in France and Spain, mainly around the Bay of Biscay. Its overall status of conservation is “unknown but not favourable” due to the lack of information from Spain and its “unfavourable-inadequate” status reported by France for future prospects parameter. The rest of individual parameters are reported as “favourable” by France.
