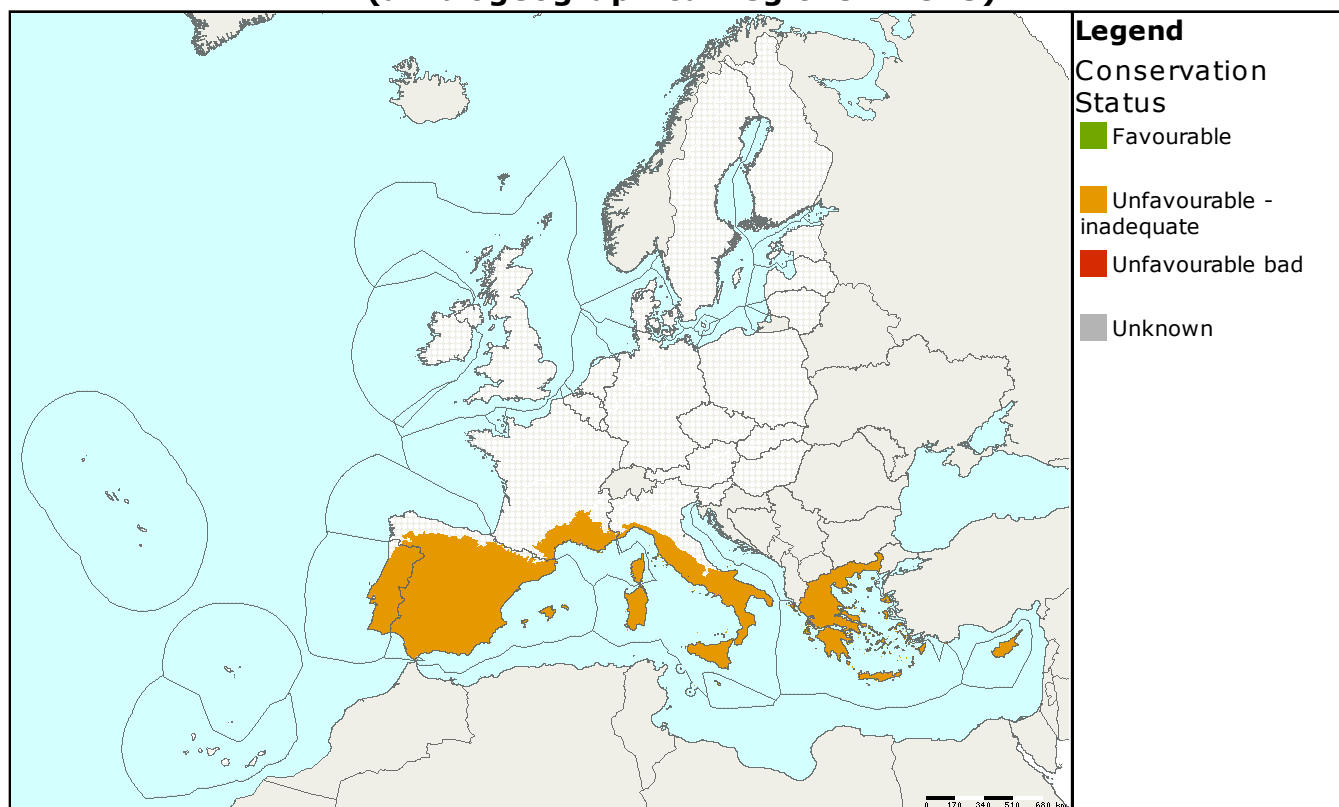

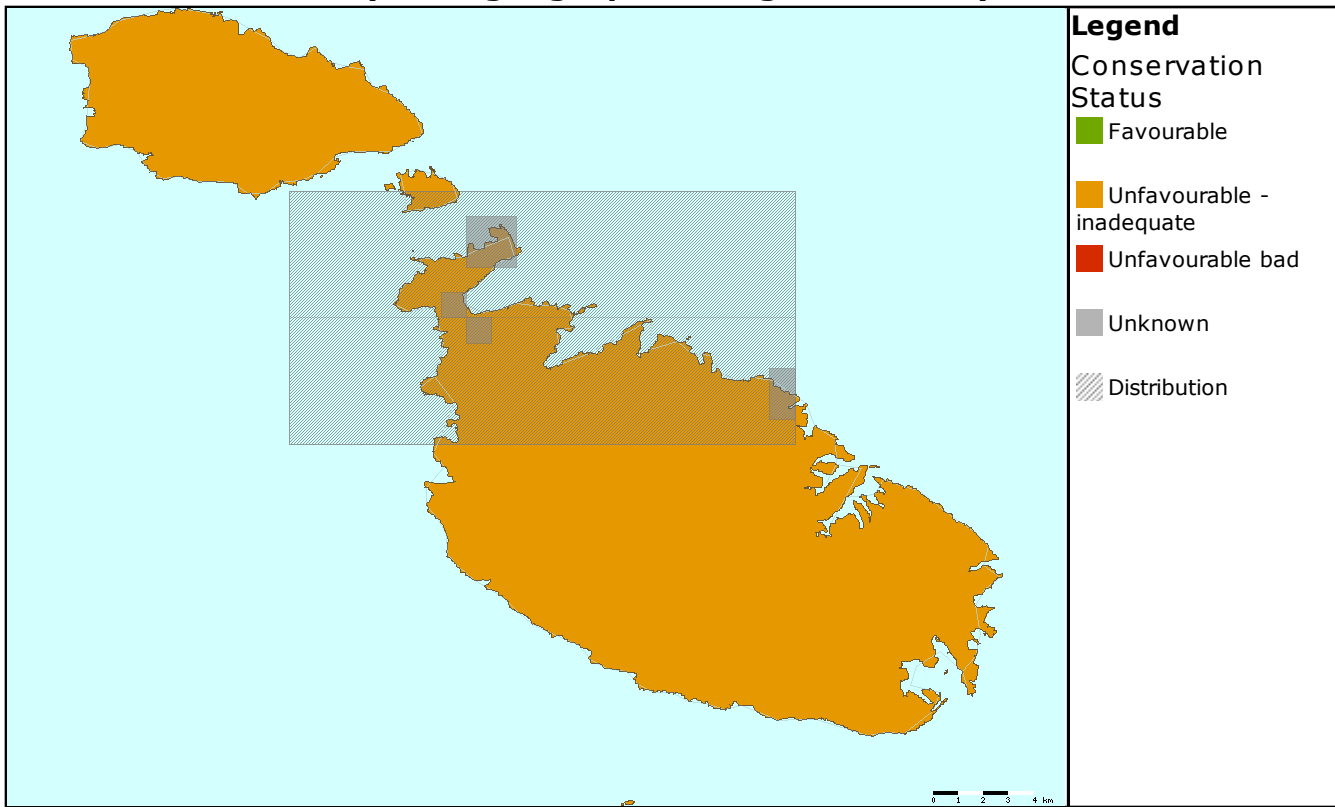

MED: Only in Malta within the EU Parasitic plant which may have started to use different host species in recent years Distribution poorly known and the species may be more common than previously thought. Host plants are widespread and not thought to be threatened but habitat destruction is a threat
