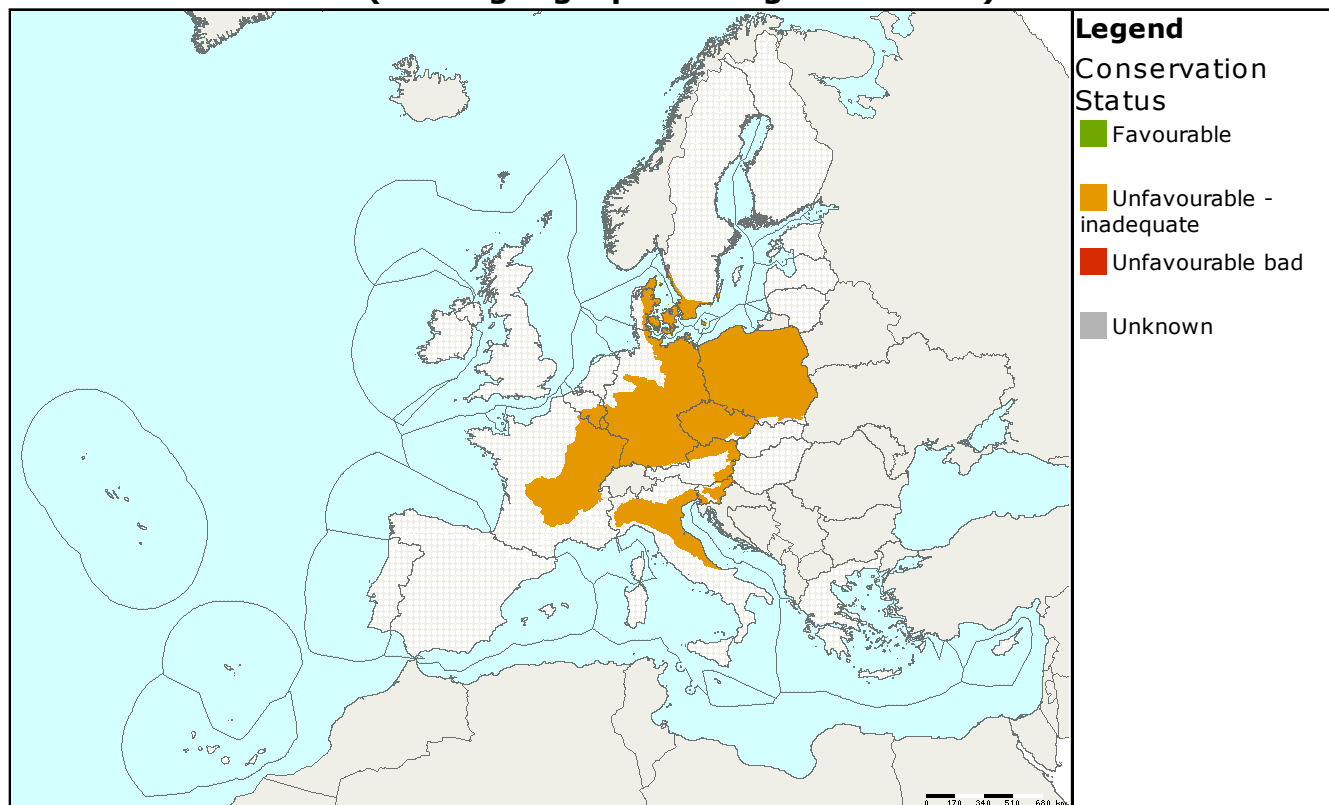

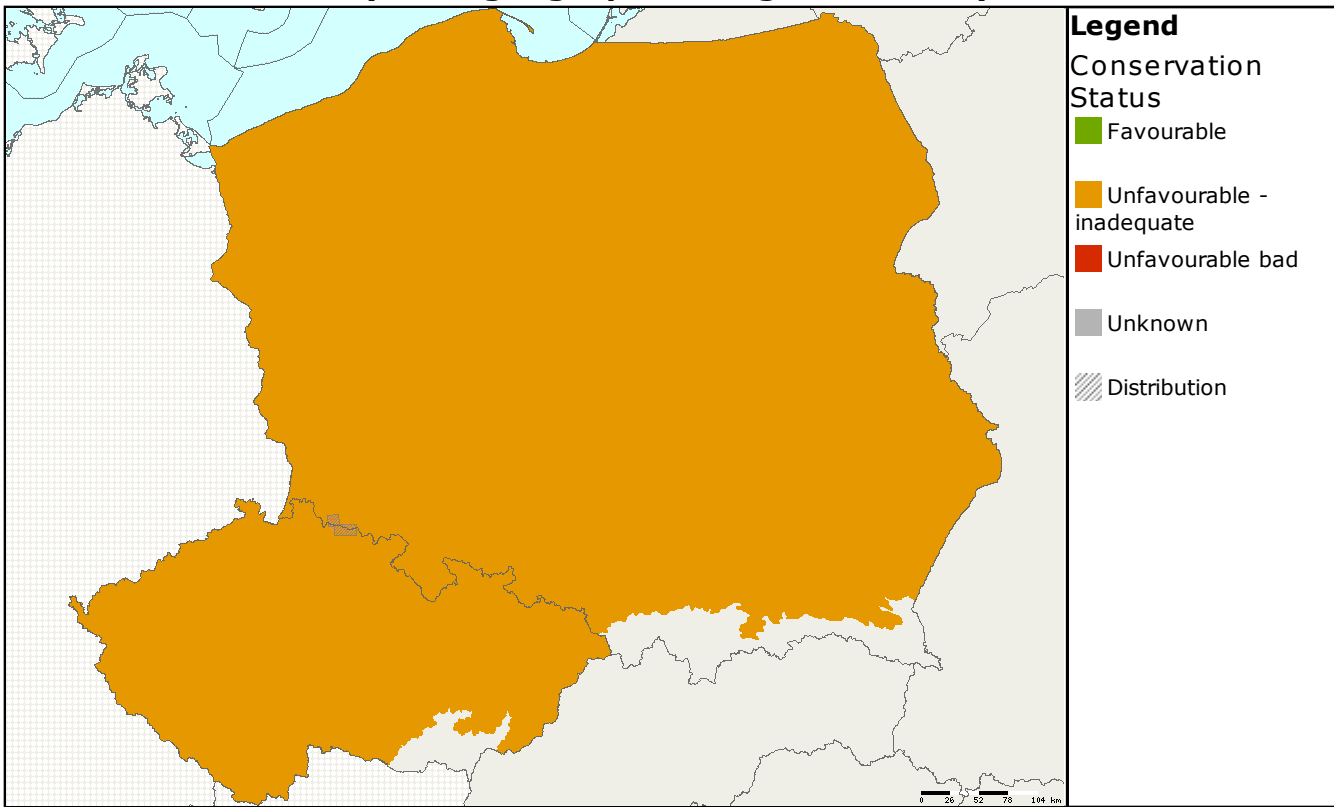

Pedicularis sudetica is a plant occurring in Poland and Czech Republic. The overall assessment for the species is "unfavourable-inadequate", despite the "favourable" Czech report for range and population parameters. The major threats to the species are the dispersion of habitation, paths, tracks, cycling tracks, walking, horse riding and non-motorised vehicles, leisure and tourism impacts, water pollution, erosion, eutrophication and acidification.
