



Physoplexis comosa is a flowering plant distributed in the Alps. Huge majority of localities are reported from Italy. Austria reports the scarcest information (population and future prospects) while in Italy only the habitat parameter is `unknown'. Despite these gaps, the overall conclusion is 'favourable' mainly due to Italian populations.
