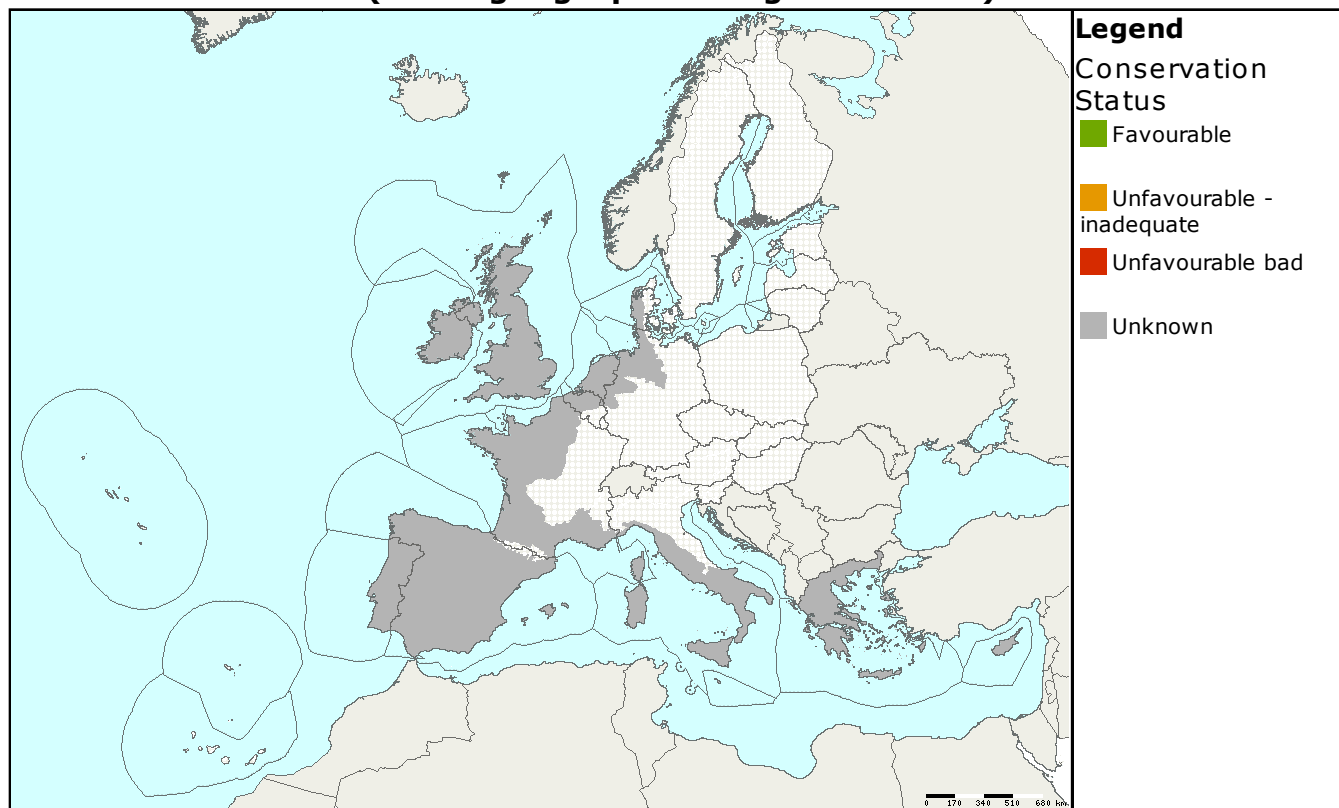

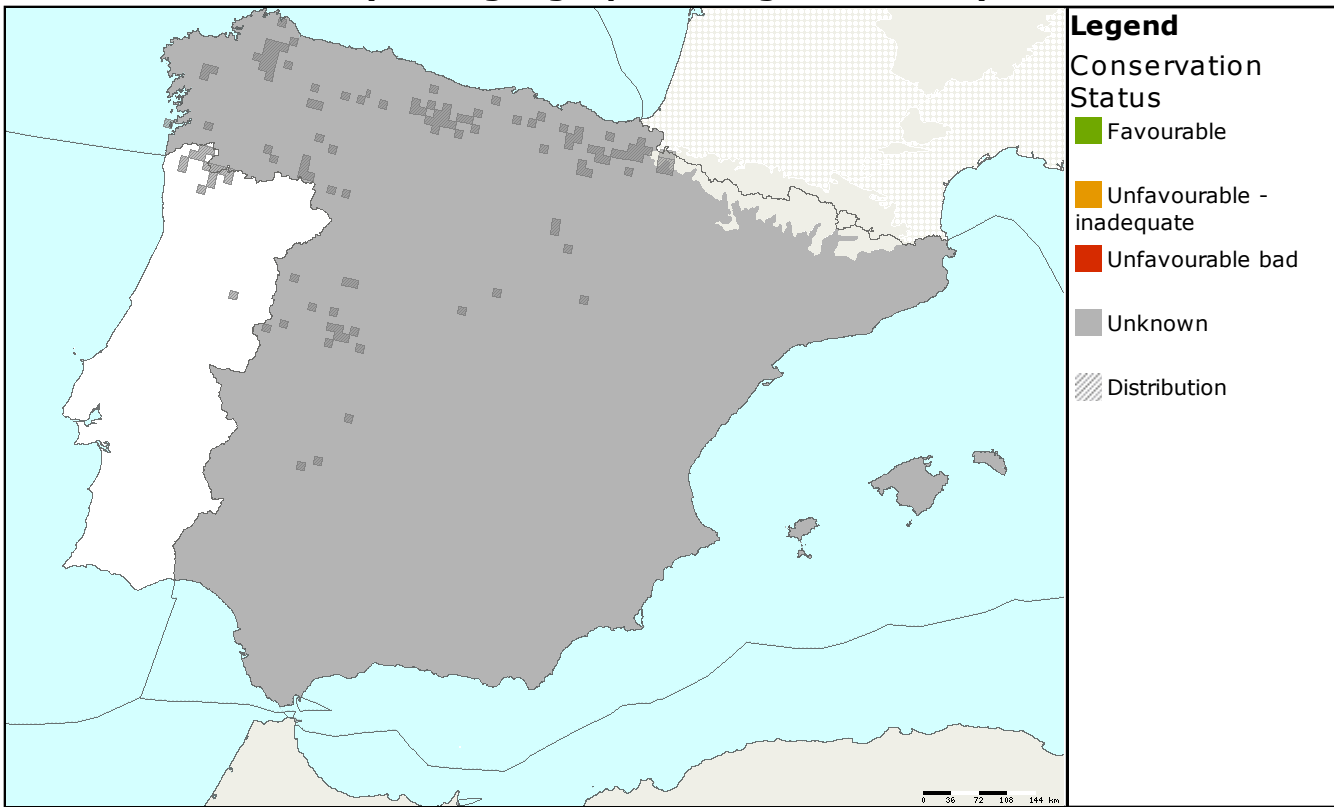

Narcissus pseudonarcissus ssp. *nobilis*, this subspecies of *N. pseudonarcissus* is endemic to the Iberian Peninsula. It occurs rarely in the mountainous region in the north of Spain and Portugal. Its occurrence is not linked with any particular habitat type. It can be found in meadows, forests and shrub formations, mostly on humid soils.

The reports for this in general poorly known species are incomplete. Conservation status was not assessed on the national level in Portugal although population size and habitat area are decreasing. The gaps in data do not allow other than 'unknown' conclusion for both the Atlantic and the Mediterranean biogeographical regions.
