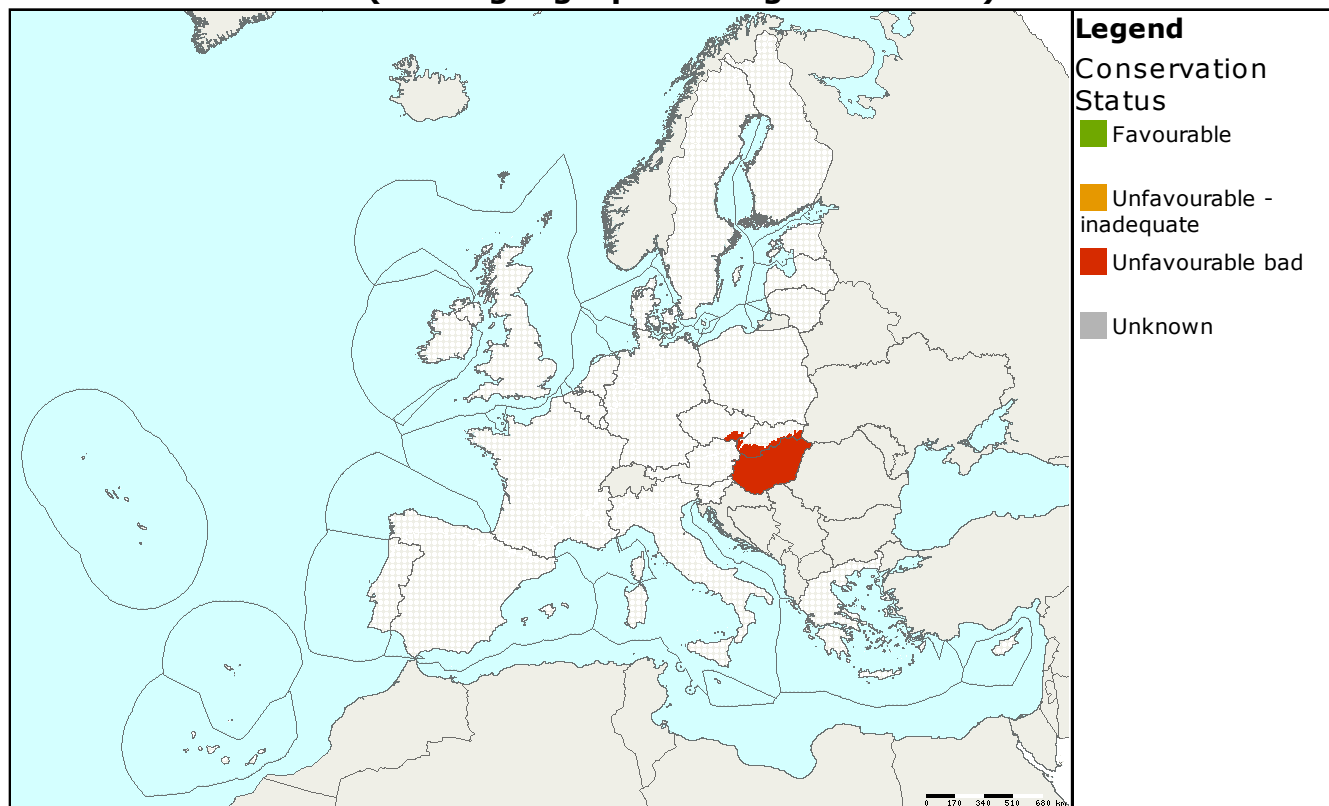

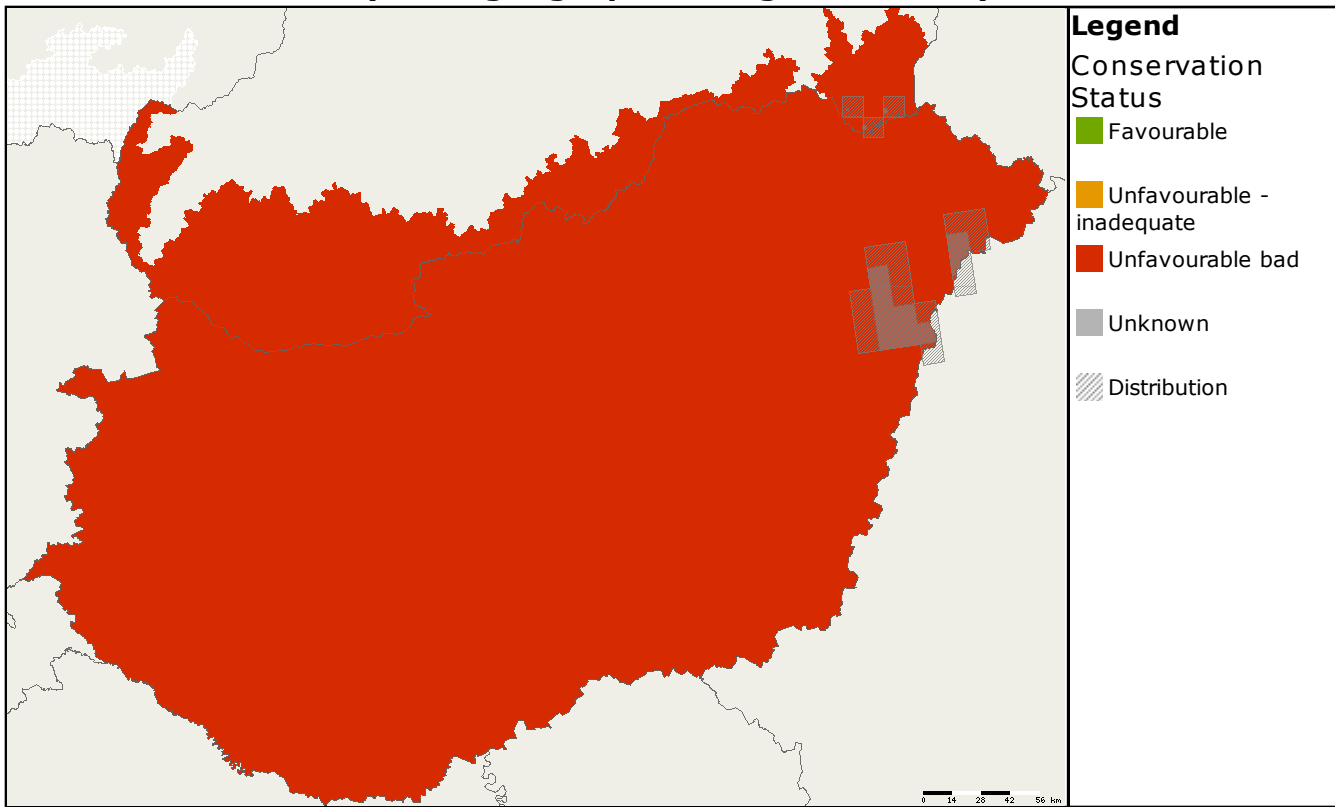

*Pulsatilla pratensis ssp. hungarica* is a plant only reported by Hungary and Slovakia. It occurs on open sand-plains, avoiding limestone. Its overall status of conservation is "unfavourable-bad", despite the habitat parameter is reported as "unfavourable-inadequate" by the two countries. The major threats to the species are modification of cultivation practices, abandonment of pastoral systems, artificial planting and invasion of alien species.
