



Rouya polygama is a plant that appears in the Mediterranean coast in France and Italy. Despite French report on range and population parameters with a "favourable" assessment, the overall status of conservation is "unfavourable-inadequate". The main threats to the species are the development of urban areas, human habitation, outdoor sports and leisure activities.
