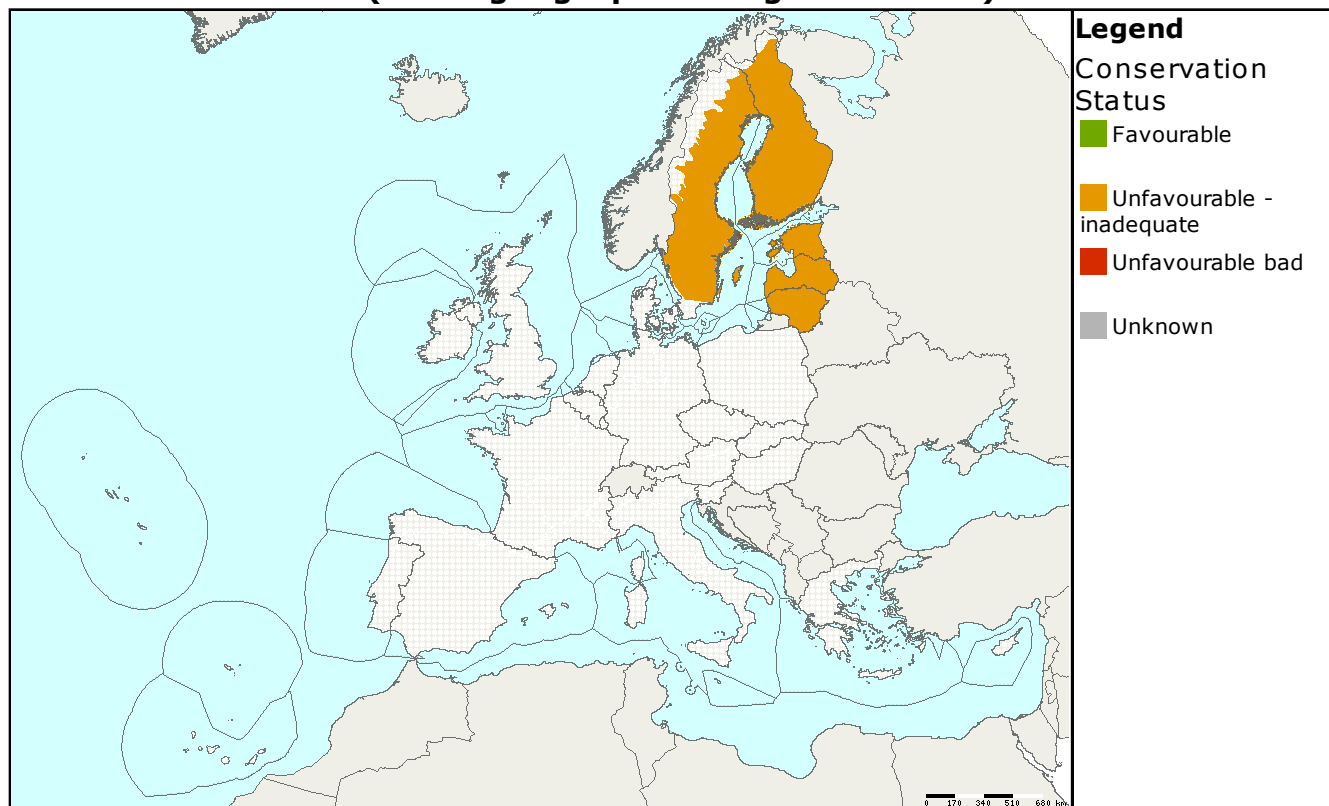

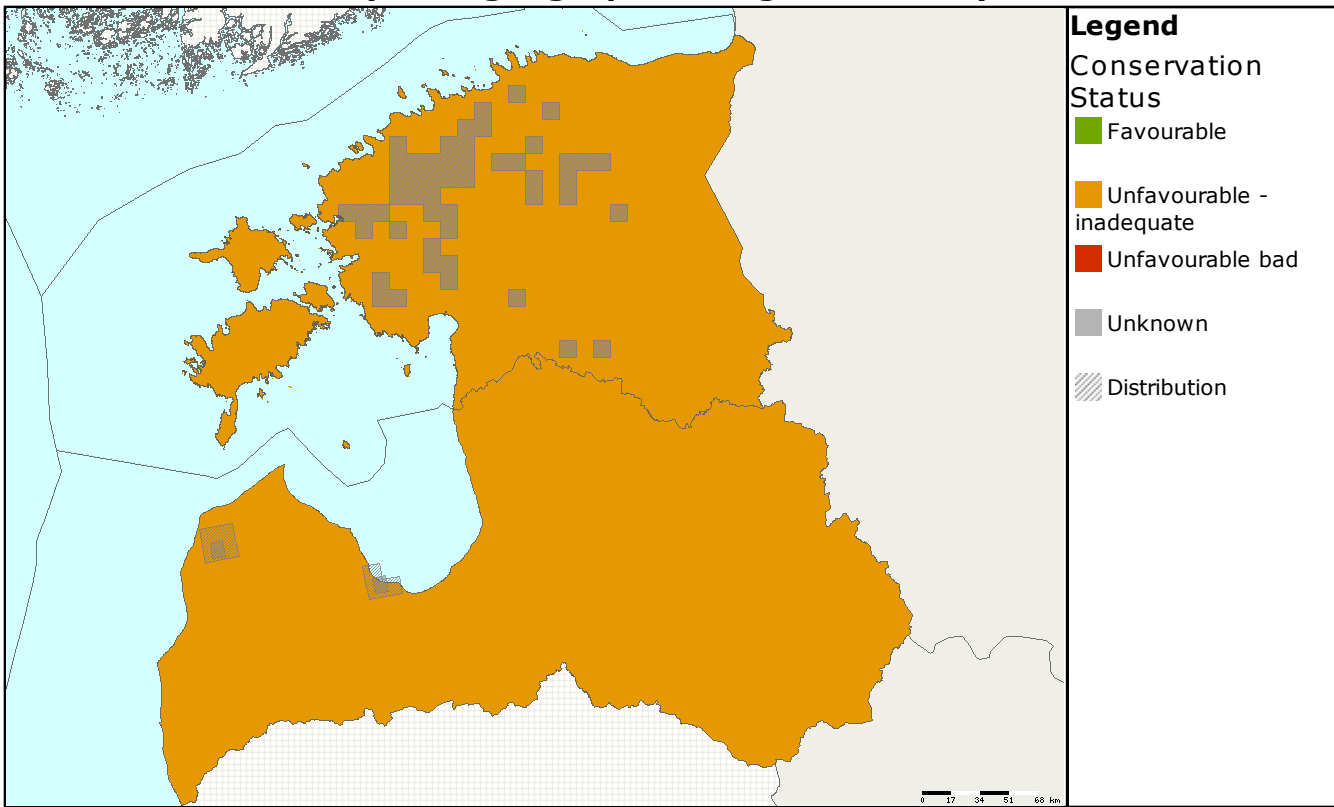

Saussurea alpina ssp. esthonica is a plant endemic to western Estonia, Latvia and northwestern Russia. The overall status of conservation for the species is "unfavourable-bad". Main threats and pressures to the species are mostly linked to land management such as forestry and agriculture including drainage.
