



Saxifraga florulenta is a plant that appears in the Alpine regions of France and Italy. In Italy only three localities are found, all in highly protected areas of the Maritime Alps. The overall status of conservation for the species is assessed as "favourable", with "unknown" data for the parameter habitat reported by Italy.
