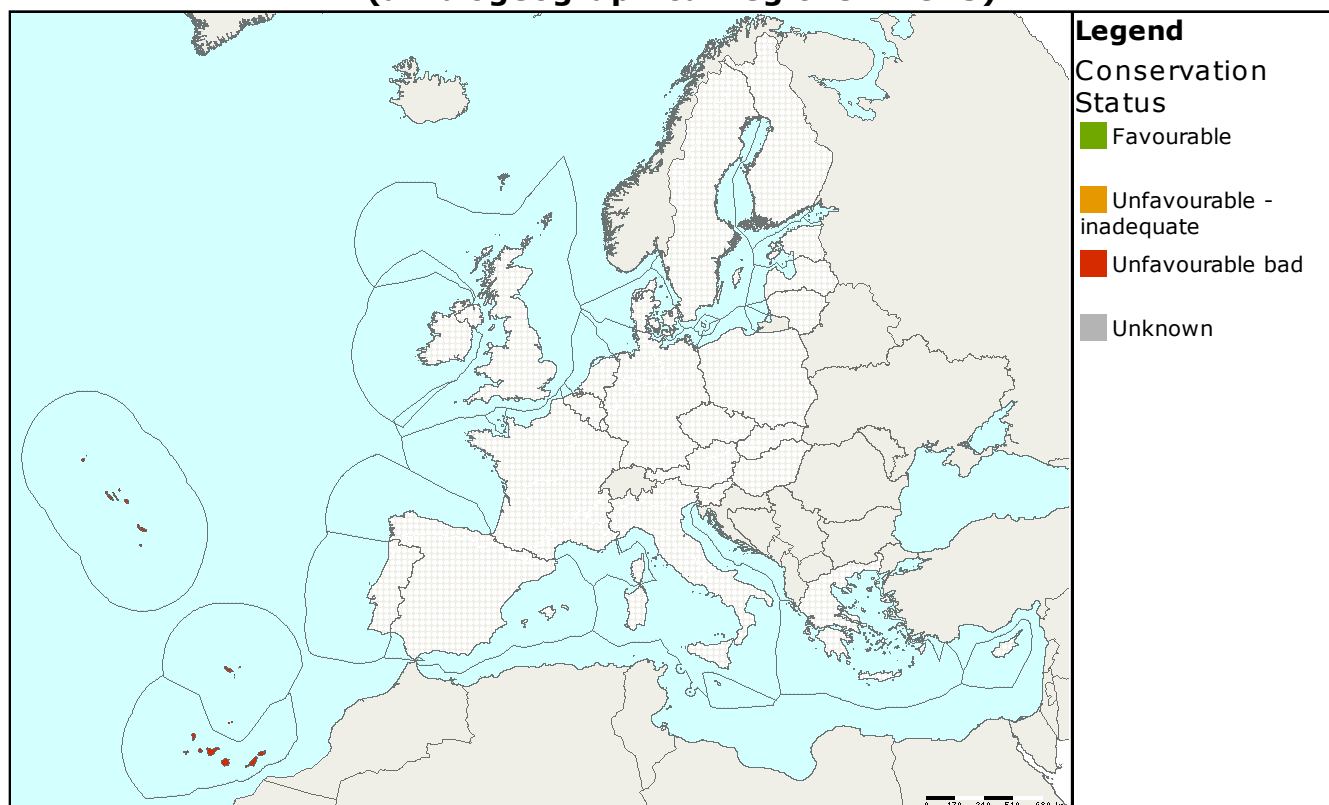

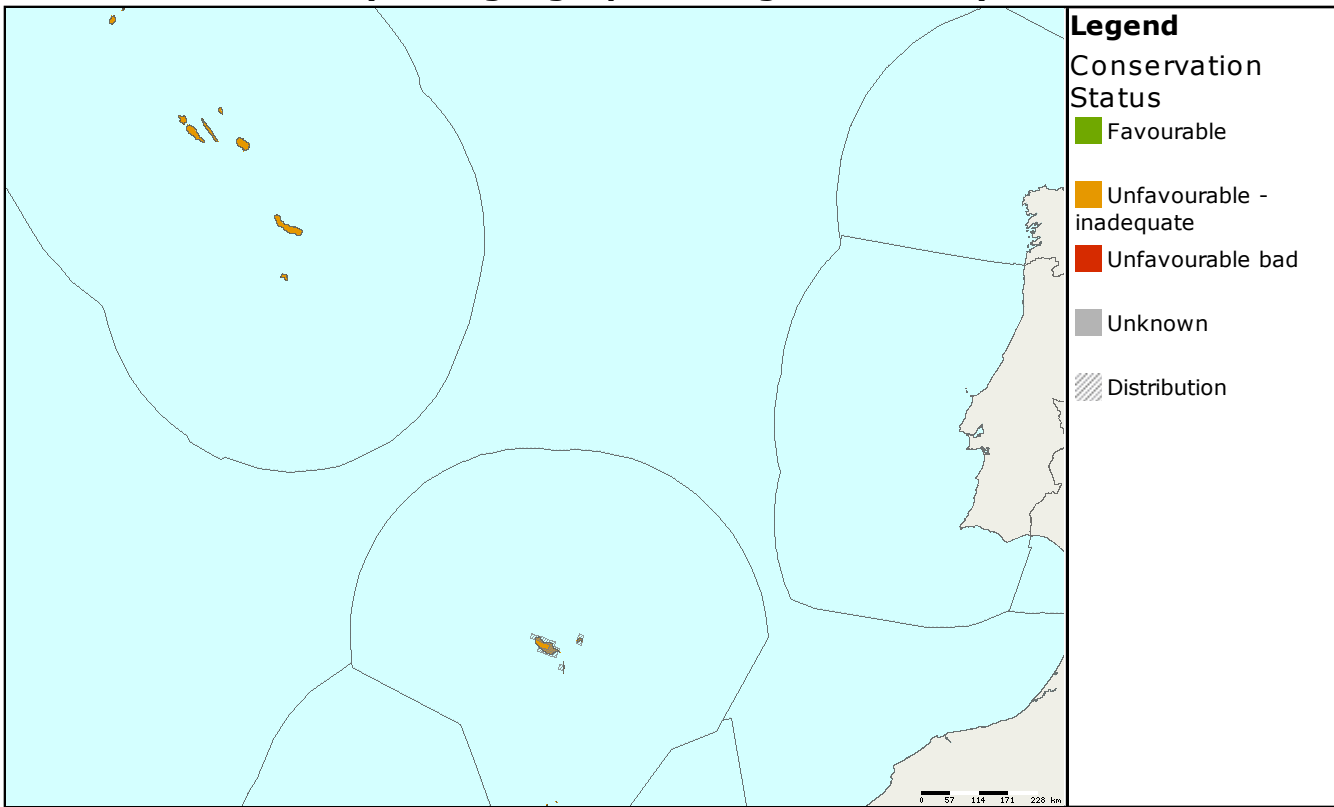

Sideroxylon marmulano is a plant occurring in the Canary Islands (Spain) and Madeira (Portugal). The overall status of conservation for the species is “unfavourable-bad” due to the Spanish report on habitat parameter. Other parameters reported by Spain are “unknown”, showing that better information is required for the species.
