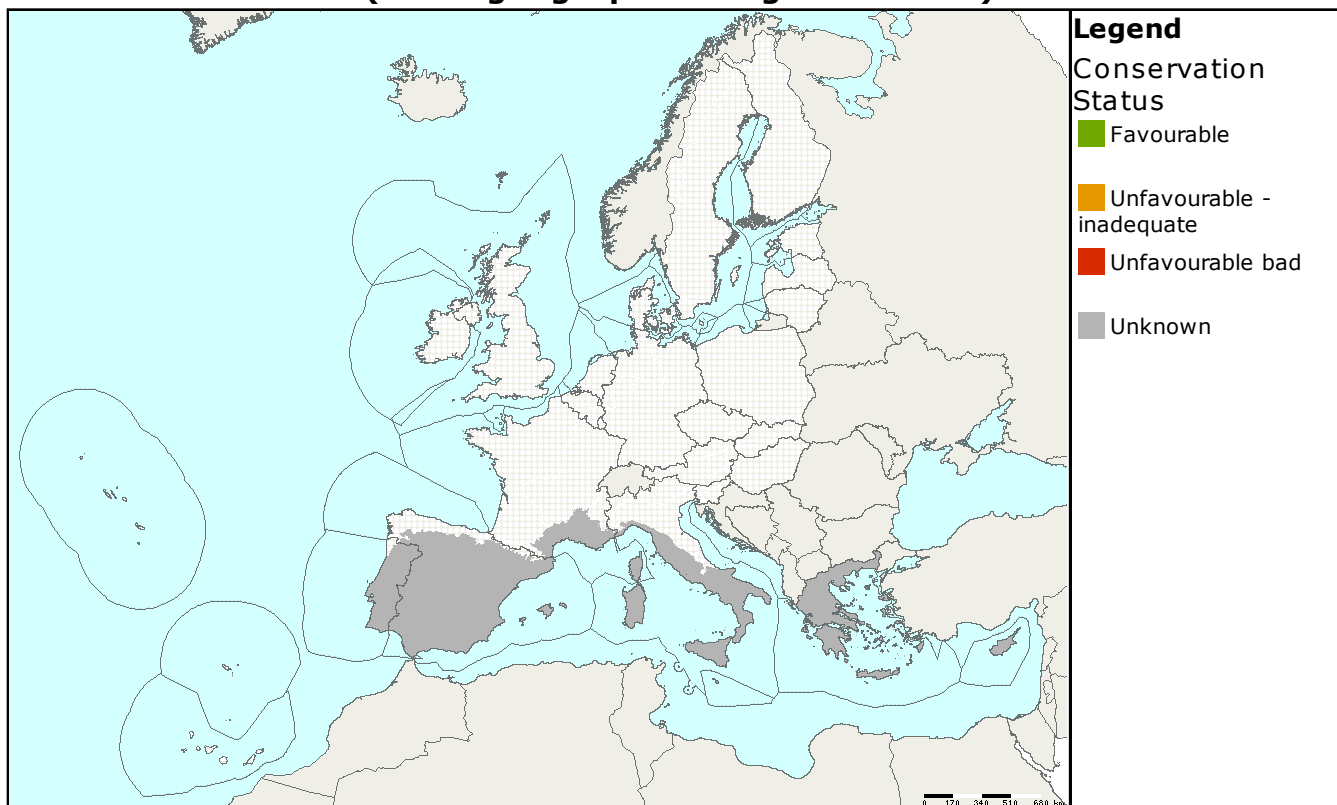

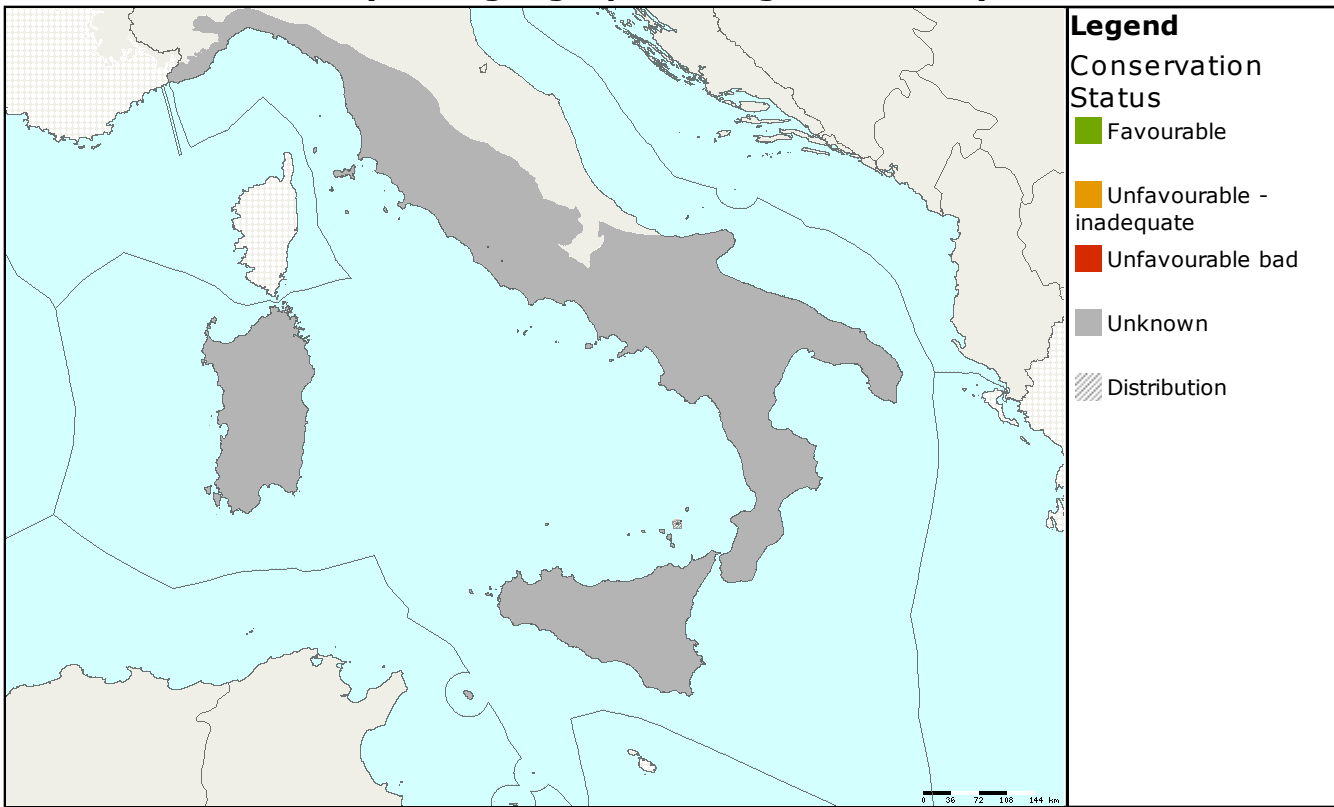

MED: Endemic to the Aeolian islands, Italy, where it grows on rocky slopes of two small volcanic islets. One of the 2 populations only has some 30 individuals so although reported as 'unknown' by Italy very unlikely to be favourable and likely to be unfavourable-bad. More complete information required from Italy. Included on IUCN list of 50 most threatened plant spp of Mediterranean islands. Considered Critically Endangered by IUCN.
