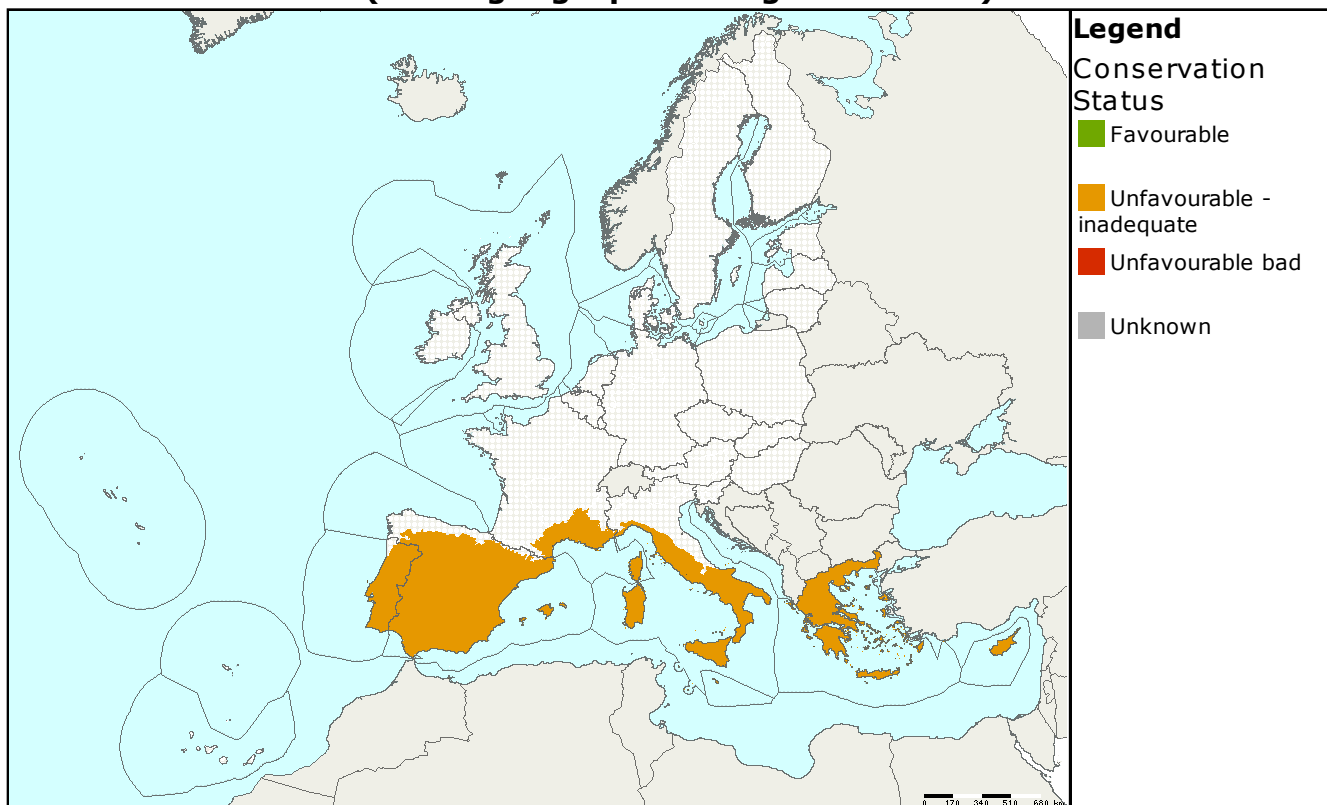

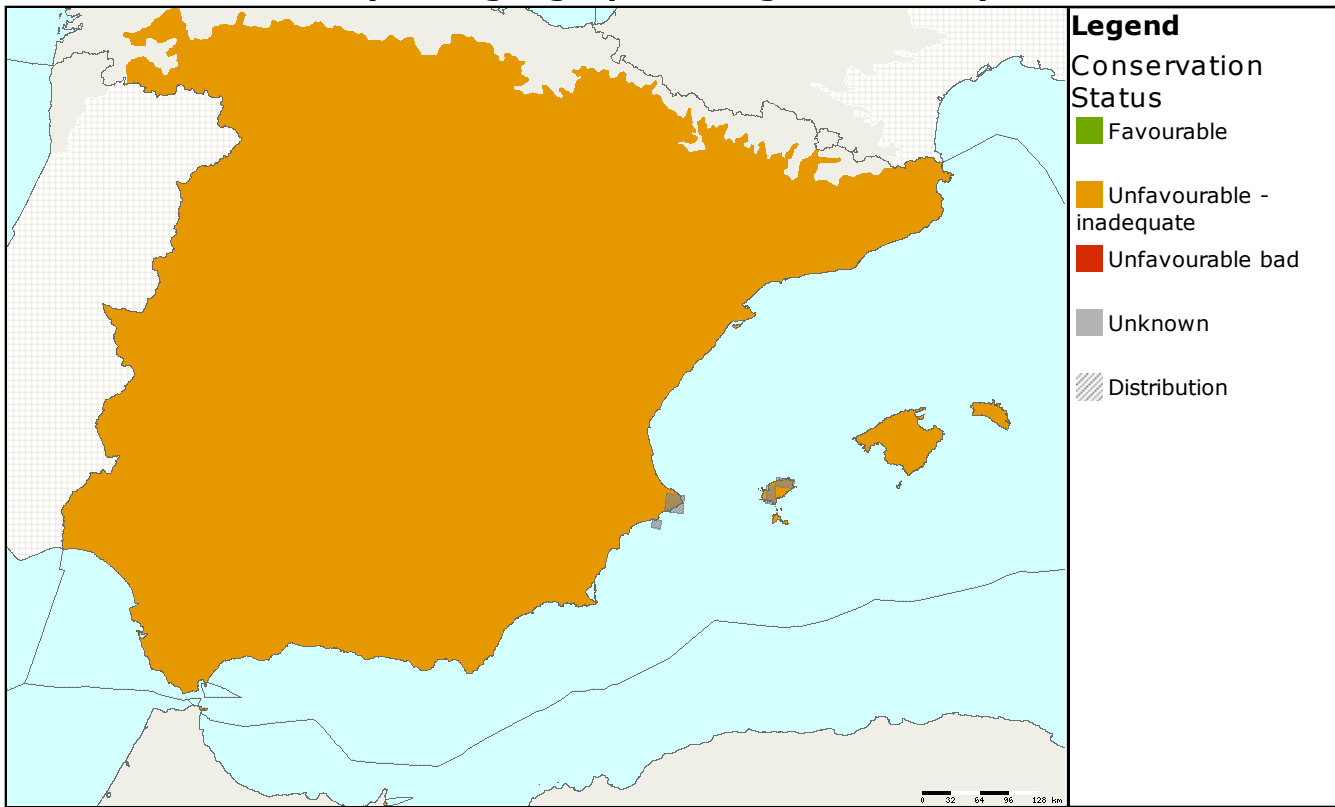

MED: Endemic to southern Spain & only known from the coasts of Alicante & Ibiza. Became extinct in the 1920s from the site where it was originally found (Peñon de Ifach) due to over collecting but now reintroduced to this site although it is too early to know if they have been successful.
