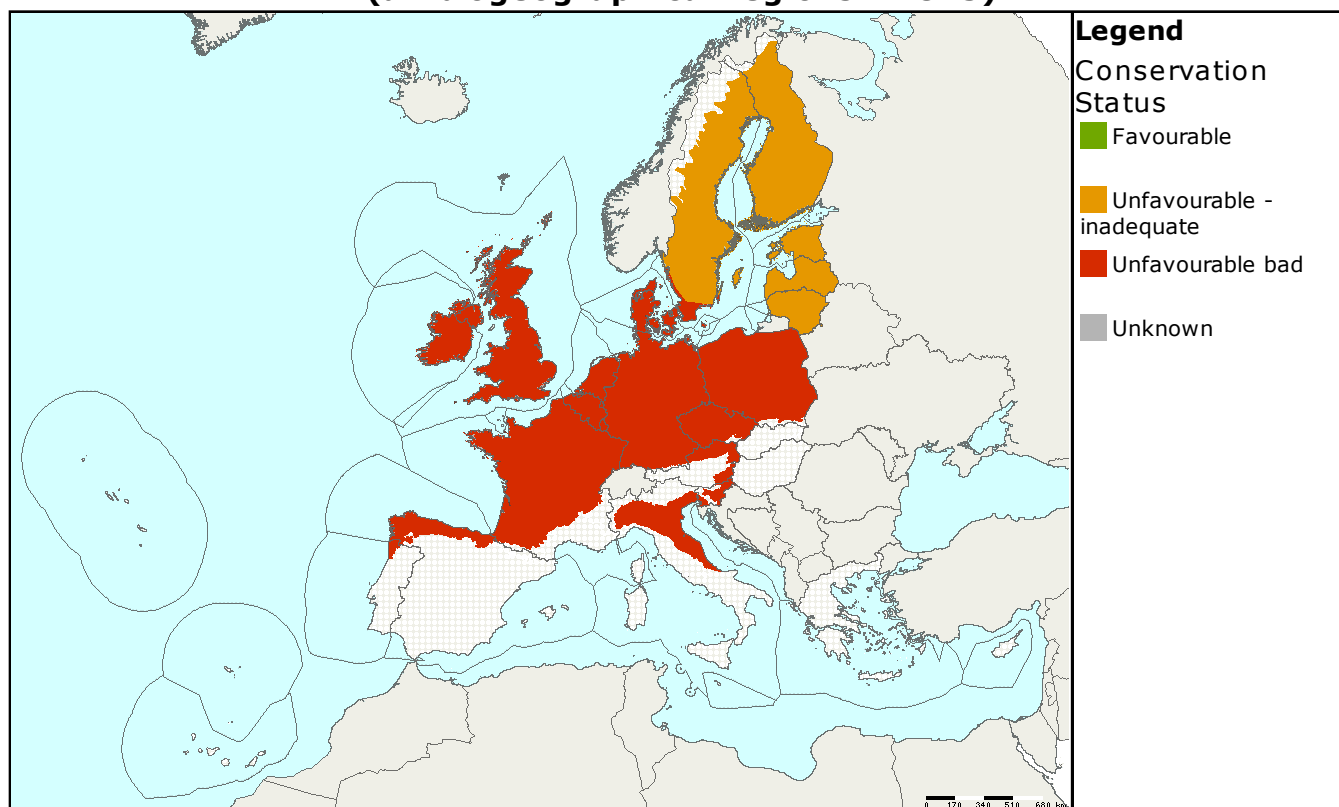

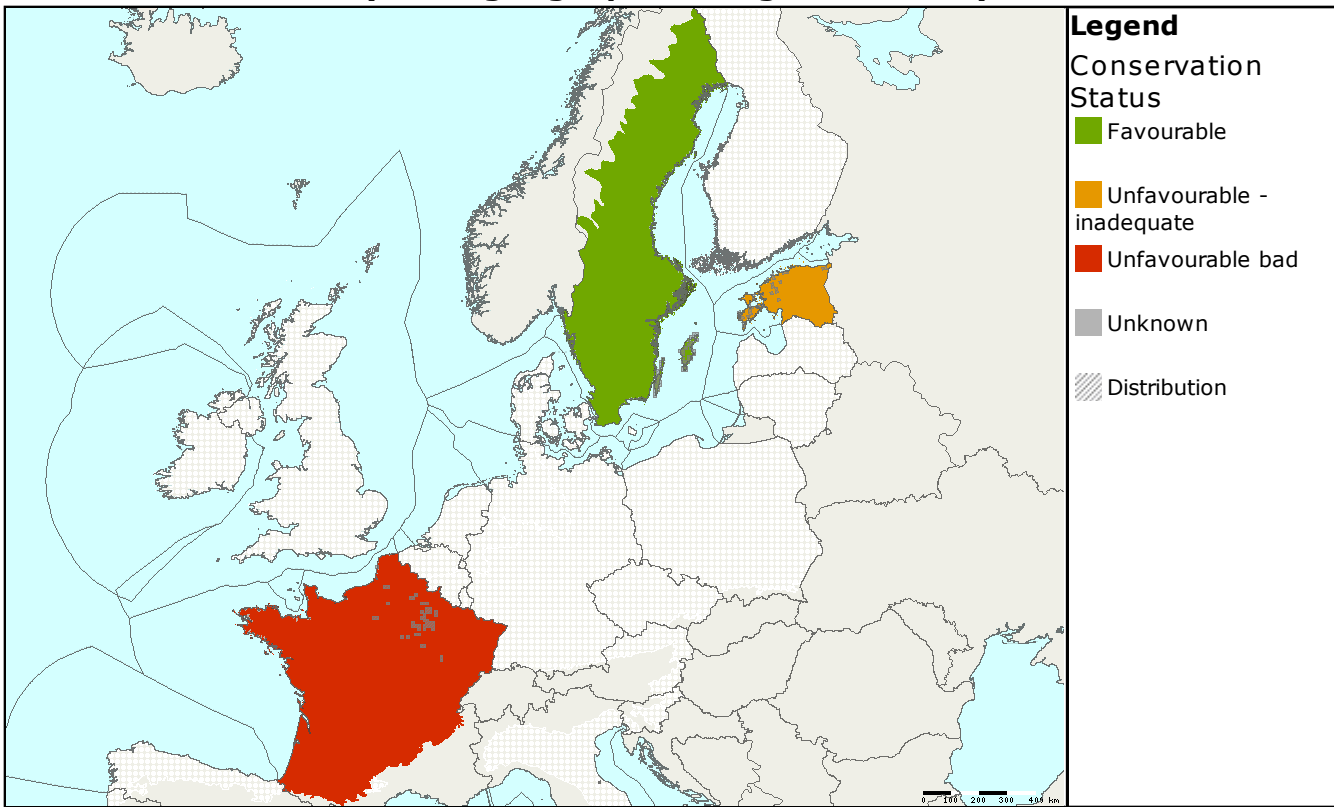

Sisymbrium supinum is a plant species which occurs in France, Sweden and Estonia (and outside the EU in Switzerland and Russia). However, it used to be present in other countries

The status of this species was assessed as ‘bad’ in the Atlantic and Continental regions, which is particularly due to the French status which was unfavourable bad. In Sweden this species is performing well, but since it was assessed as **‘inadequate’ in Estonia the overall assessment for the Boreal region is ‘inadequate’. This species has already become extinct in Germany, Latvia and the Netherlands (in Russia it is considered to be ‘Critically Endangered’).
