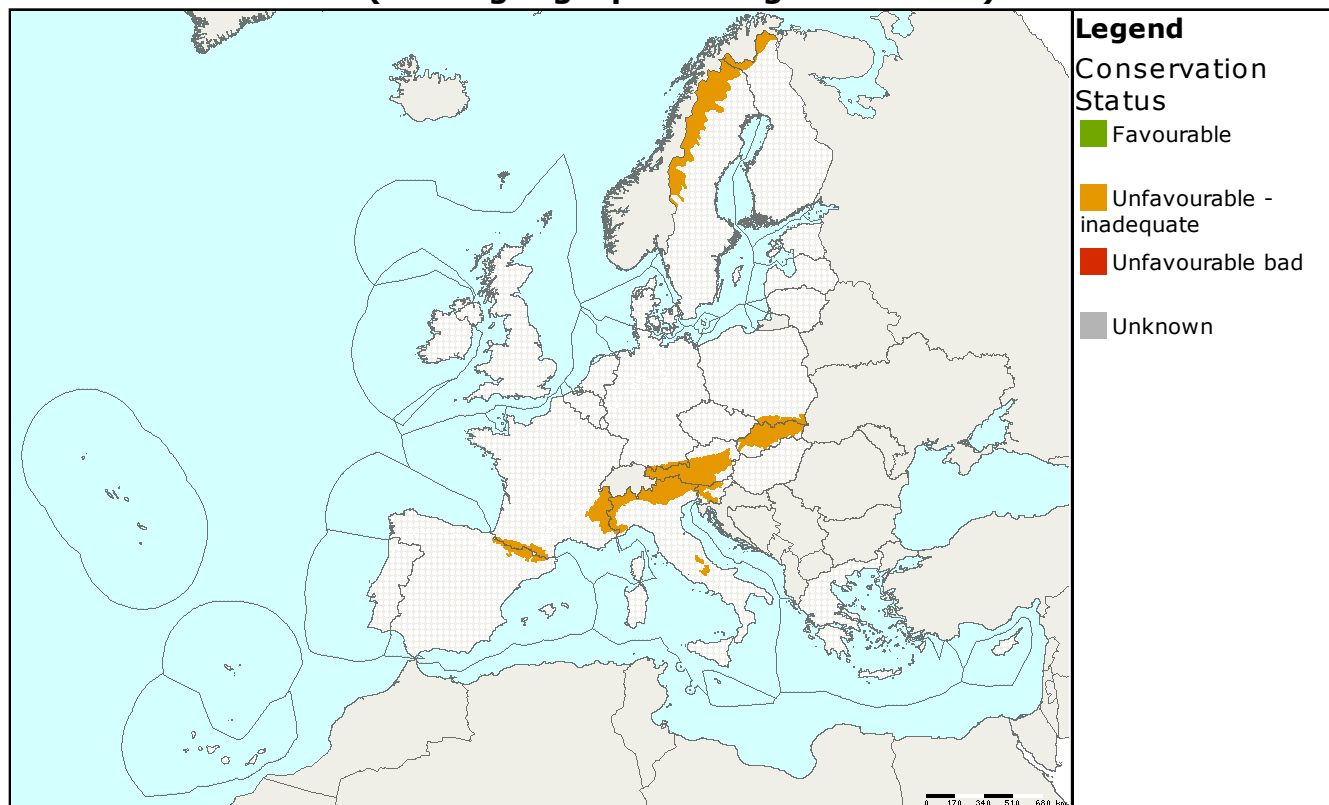

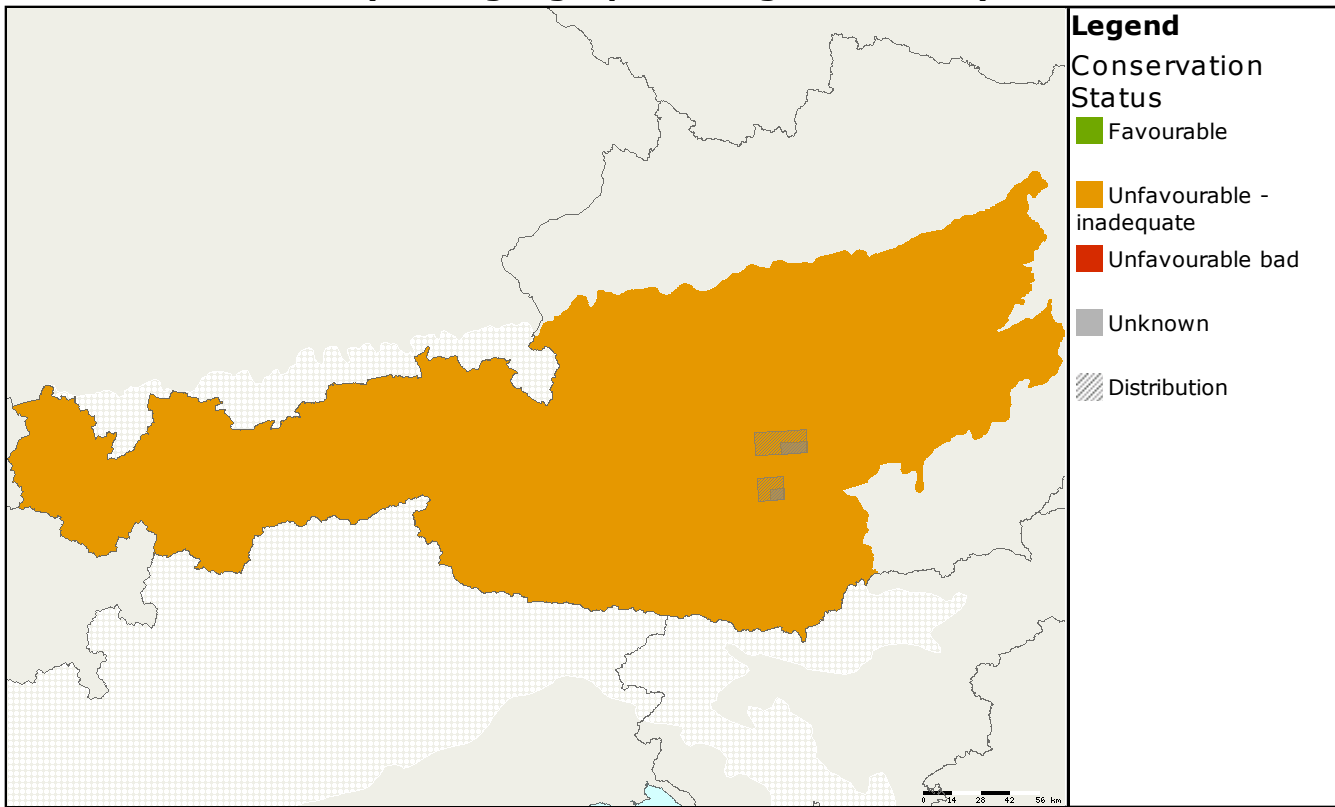

ALP: Reported only from one area in the Steiermark Alps. Even though the range is "favourable", the rest of parameters are "inadequate", although future prospects were improved through effective conservation measures. Overall conclusion "inadequate" mainly due to population and habitat.
