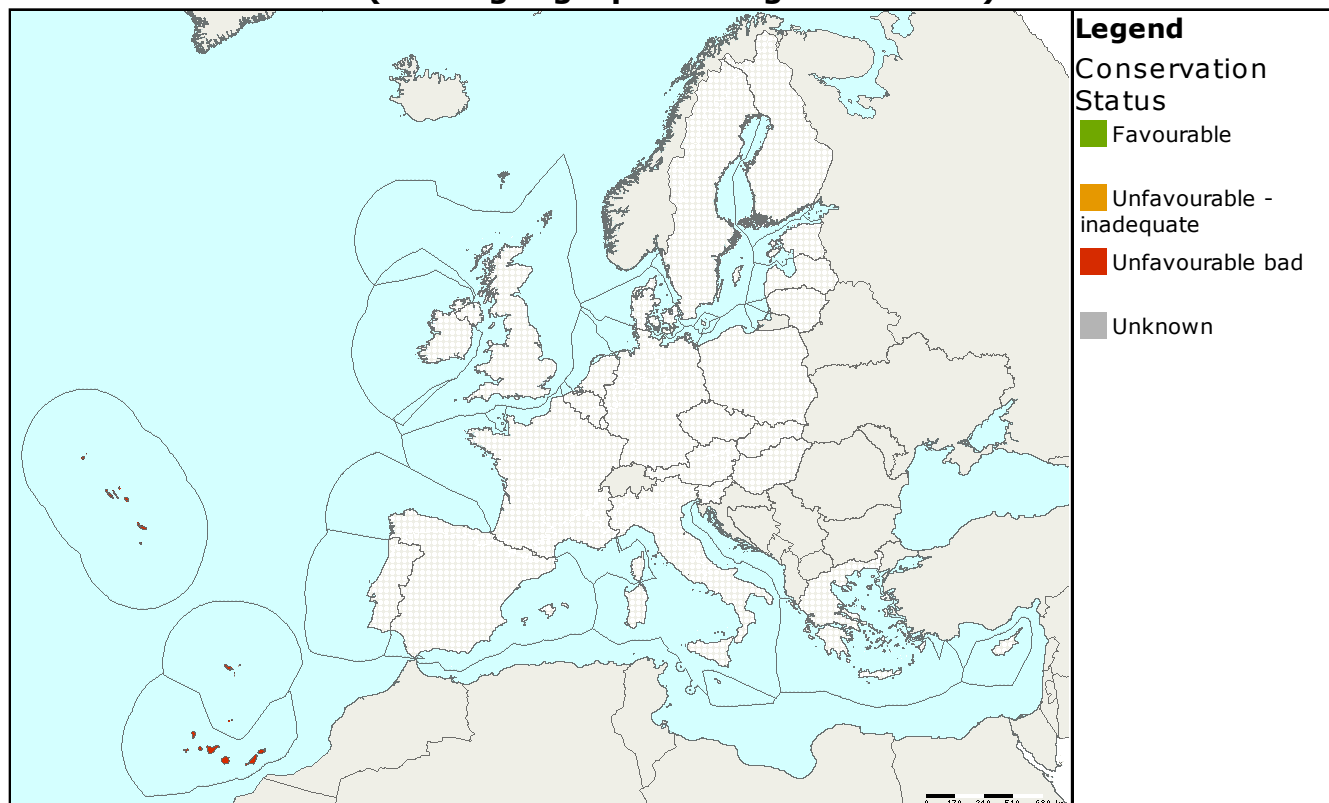

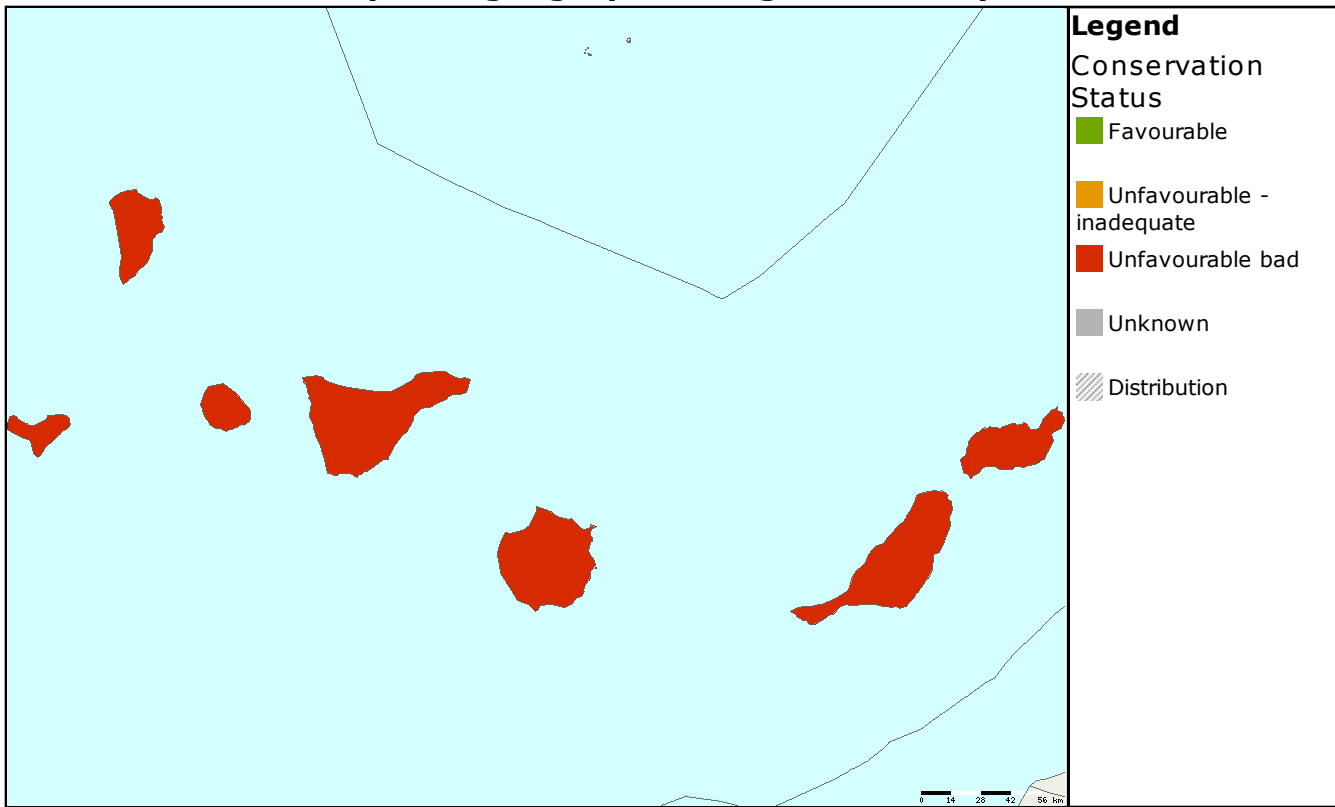

Habitat described as 'unknown' but RDB suggests unfavourable, probably 'unfavourable-bad' with habitat destruction and pressures from nearby construction. Considered CR in the Spanish RDB.
