



A fescue endemic to the Iberian Peninsula. It occurs in the mountainous regions of north-western part of the Iberian Peninsula. It can be found mainly in rupicolous grasslands on acid soils.

The reports for this in general poorly known species are incomplete. The conservation status was not assessed by Portugal. The status in the Mediterranean biogeographical region is 'unknown'. In the Atlantic biogeographical region it was assessed as 'unfavourable inadequate' due to the poor future prospects of the Atlantic populations in Portugal. However better information is required to allow comprehensive assessment. The species is not considered particularly endangered in any of the countries.
