



Trifolium saxatile is a plant distributed rather equally in Alpine biogeographical region of France, Austria and Italy. In Italy its situation is 'favourable', while in France and Austria its 'future prospects' and overall assessments are 'unfavourable-inadequate'. Conclusion for biogeographical region is also 'unfavourable-inadequate'.
