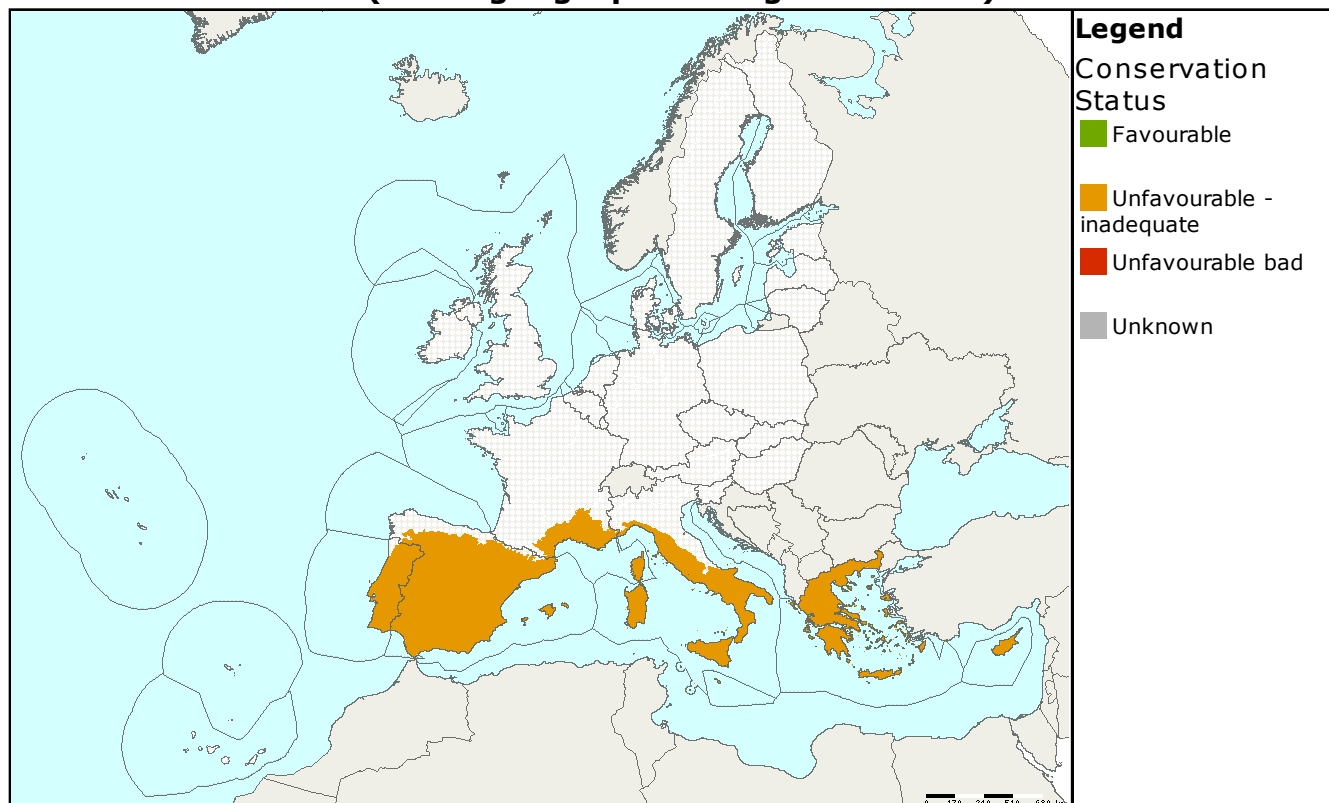

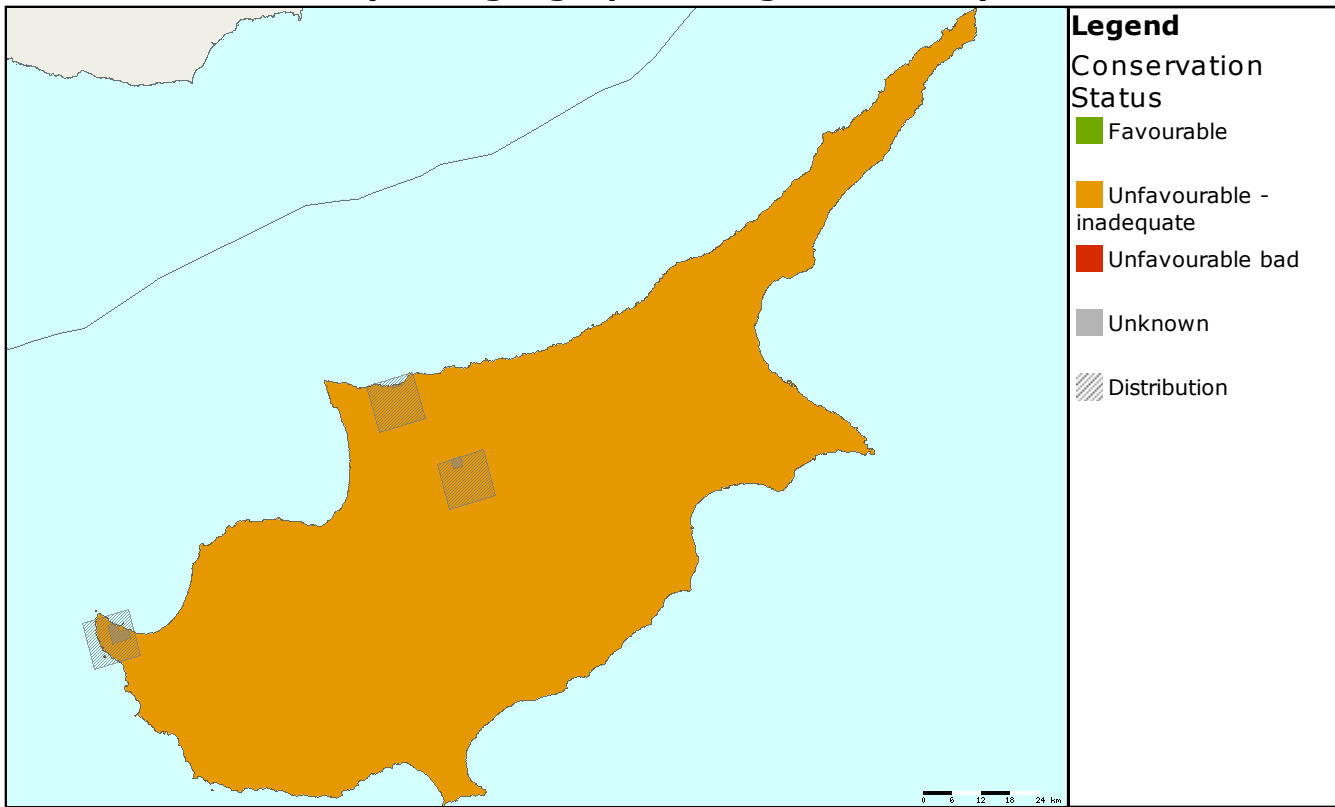

MED: The species occurs at 2 locations in the area controlled by the government of Cyprus, with 1700 and 300 individuals respectively. Assessed as unfavourable-inadequate due to population although Cypriot NGOs claim that due to habitat destruction both habitat and future prospects are also unfavourable with important sites not protected
