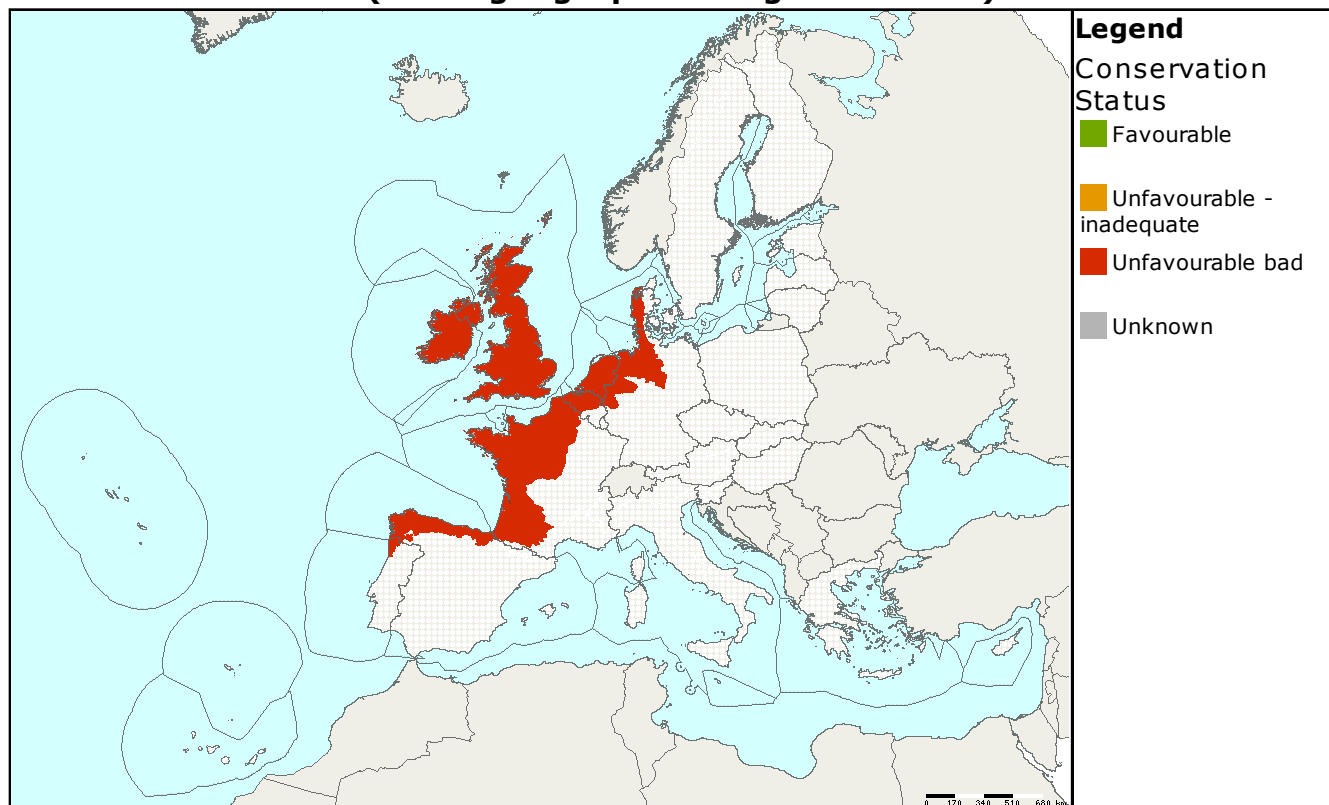

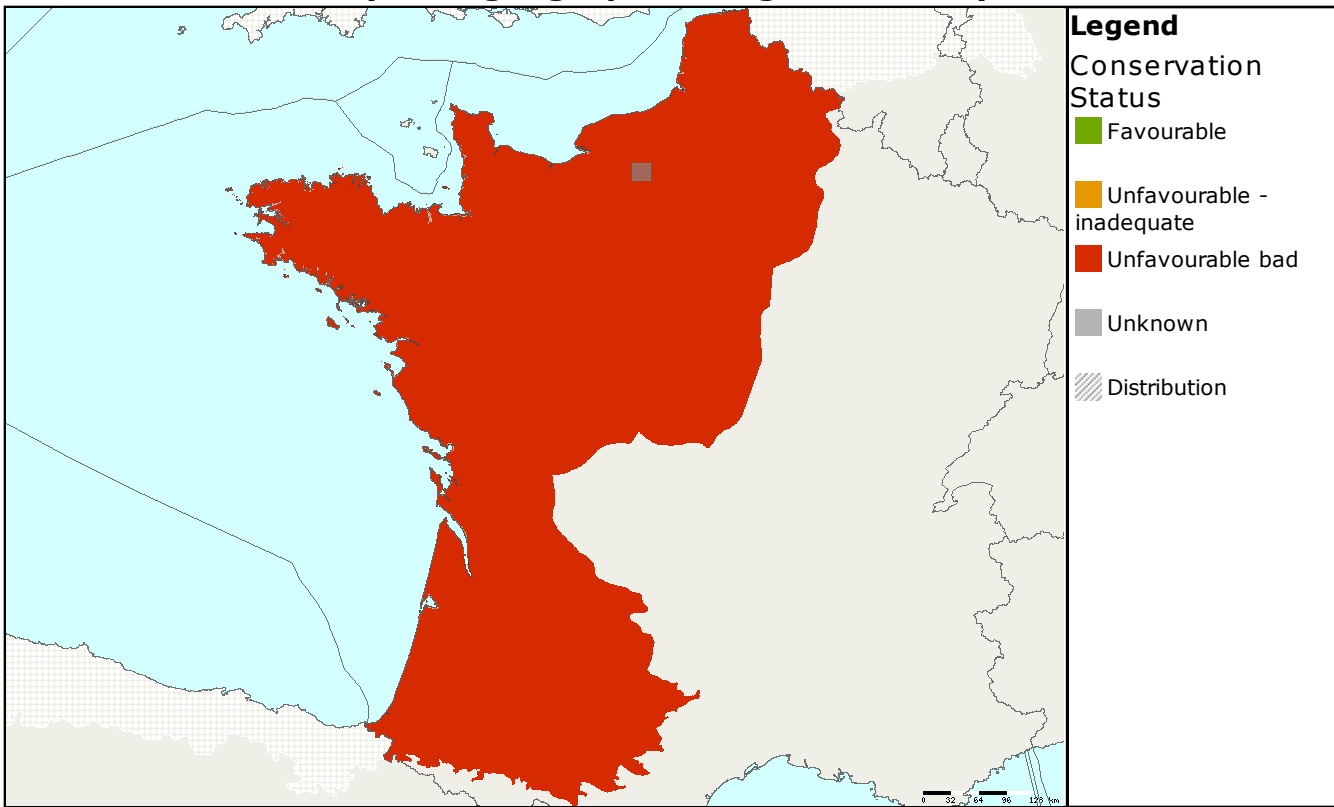

ATL: Endemic to the Seine valley near Rouen, Northern France. More widespread in the past but the range has been considerably reduced. The biggest threat is the stabilisation & closure of the habitat which is scree and rocky slopes. There is an action plan for this species developed by a LIFE project.
