



Alisma wahlenbergii is short-living perennial, aquatic plant endemic for Baltic region (Boreal biogeographical region). Species grows in shallow, slightly brackish waters. It is distributed in western Finland and south-eastern Sweden. In the past recorded in Lithuania as well (not reported in this assessment). Outside the European Union occurs in Russia (Gulf of Finland). Although the partial evaluations of 'range' and 'population' are indicated as 'favourable', the species' 'habitat' and 'future prospect' were assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate'. That led to the overall assessment of conservation status being 'unfavourable-inadequate' as well.
